Background

The Evansville Region has embraced the "E is for Everyone" brand as a guiding principle, reflecting our community's aspiration to becoming more inclusive. While significant progress has been made in advancing Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI), there is still much work ahead to fully embed these values into the fabric of our organizational cultures.

Since its foundation in 2002 as a nonprofit organization, HOLA has been dedicated to fostering appreciation for cultural diversity and promoting the successful inclusion of Latinos in the community. In collaboration with Ivy Tech Community College, the University of Evansville, the University of Southern Indiana and the Evansville Regional Economic Partnership (E-REP), we developed a comprehensive leadership series aimed at achieving the following outcome:

To equip participants with advanced professional development training that enhances their skills, expands their knowledge, and sharpens their strategic thinking. This training empowers participants to navigate complex challenges, make meaningful contributions, and foster a culture

of innovation, belonging, and continuous growth within their workplaces, communities, and organizations.







The HOLA Professional Development Series is a comprehensive program delivered by faculty members from our three higher education partners, in combination with keynote speakers. Participants will attend six full-day sessions, rotating among the three institutions, over the course of a year and culminating in a graduation ceremony.

We are inviting organizations to identify and sponsor up and coming professionals, business owners and/or suppliers, that can participate in the fourth cohort of this program, with the goal of preparing them for career advancement within the organization or business.

The Fourth Cohort will start at Ivy Tech Community College on August 1st, 2025
