## Nahar Torah Niddah Series #7 Mechaber & Rama Seif Aleph

## בזכות החיילים הקדושים ששומרים על ארצינו – הקב"ה יגן עליהם בכל מקום שהם.

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Now that we've gone through a good introduction and understood some main topics within *hilchos niddah*, we're ready to see our first *seif* in *Yoreh Deah*. Recall, we have 4 requirements to make the woman *niddah d'orysa*:

- 1. Comes from the uterus
- 2. The blood *leaves* the uterus and enters the *prozdor*
- 3. Hargasha
- 4. Correct color

Let's see how they find their way into halacha. the Mechaber<sup>1</sup> paskins:

Meaning, any way the blood leaves the uterus it will make her niddah – requirements one, two and four – four can be inferred from the word  $\Box 7$  – i.e. if its not the right color then it isnt blood. The *Mechaber* continues:

## והוא שתרגיש ביציאתו

But this is only if she had a *hargasha* – the third requirement! Lastly, the *Mechaber paskins*:

Even if she sees only a drop of blood (the size of a mustard seed- *chardal*) she needs to count *zayin n'kiyim*.

The *Rama*<sup>2</sup> ends off the *siman* by saying that there is no distincition within *niddah* between a married and non-married woman:

Meaning, once she turns 12 she is an *issur niddah*! Thus, from the moment she is 12 until she goes to the *mikvah*, she is *temeah niddah*.

The question then becomes- why don't we allow a single woman to go to the mikvah?

The *Shut Rivash*<sup>3</sup> explains that we aren't *metaken* a single woman to go to the *mikvah* beceause if she would go to the *mikvah* then we are going to be *machshil* people to be with a non married woman.
