1. Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

JP Services (South West) Limited is committed to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 2050, in line with the UK Government's targets and sustainability commitments.

2. Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline Year: 2022

4. Emissions Reduction Targets

JP Services (South West) Limited is targeting:

25% reduction in total emissions by 2030 from the 2022 baseline.

50% reduction in Scope 1 and 2 emissions by 2035. Net Zero emissions across all scopes by 2050. To achieve these, we have implemented and planned the following initiatives. 5. Carbon Reduction Initiatives Already Implemented (since 2022): Fleet upgrade: Replaced 30% of diesel vehicles with electric vans (EVs). Office energy improvements: Switched to 100% renewable electricity. Waste management: Introduced recycling across all sites and reduced skip usage through smarter materials ordering. Staff training: Carbon awareness sessions rolled out to all employees. Digital transformation: Shifted from paper-based to digital job management and invoicing systems. Planned (2025-2030): Full EV fleet by 2030: Phase out all internal combustion engine vehicles. Solar PV installation at the company HQ and workshop facilities. Supplier engagement: Introduce carbon assessment criteria into procurement for subcontractors and suppliers. Low-carbon building practices: Promote modular builds, use of recycled materials, and lifecycle

emissions analysis on key projects.

Remote monitoring and smart controls for energy use on temporary project sites.

6. Carbon Offsetting Strategy

From 2028 onwards, unavoidable emissions will be offset via accredited schemes such as:

UK woodland creation projects

Verified Carbon Standard (VCS) schemes

Investing in local renewable energy cooperatives

Offsetting will only be used as a last resort after reduction options are exhausted.

7. Governance and Reporting

Carbon Champion Appointed: The Operations Director leads our carbon strategy, with quarterly board updates.

Annual Reporting: Emissions will be measured and published annually.

Third-Party Verification: From 2026, we aim to have our footprint verified via ISO 14064 or a similar recognised framework.
