

The Root 66 Community Garden - Membership & Plot Agreement

Thank you for your interest in The Root 66 Community Garden! Our membership year runs from April 1st to March 31st. Anyone joining after April 30th will have their annual fee prorated. Plot fees must be paid in full by April 1st each year unless other arrangements are made. Membership is only valid with a signed agreement and a paid plot fee. This agreement remains in effect unless changes are made or it is canceled by either the member or management.

Annual Plot Fees

- 4' x 8' Raised Bed \$110/year X 2
- 4' x 10' Raised Bed \$125/year
- 5' x 10' Raised Bed \$140/year
- 10' x 10' In-Ground Plot \$165/year
- 10' x 20' In-Ground Plot \$220/year
- 20' x 20' In-Ground Plot \$330/year
- FoodShare Membership \$15/month or \$150/year (included with Plot Membership)
- Ask for a Senior Discount (10%) applies for ages 65+ or full-time students with proof of enrollment
- For low-income applicants, please inquire about the availability of Sponsored Plots

Participation Requirements

To participate in the Root 66 Community Garden, you must:

- 1. Submit a completed and signed membership application and make payment upon approval.
- 2. Agree to all garden guidelines and policies.

3. If no plots are available, submit an application to be added to the waiting list and make payment when approved.

Member Rules and Regulations

By signing this agreement, I pledge to:

- 1. Read and follow all garden rules and regulations, including the attached information, Bee Safety guidelines, and the Hold Harmless Agreement.
- 2. Keep my plot and the surrounding areas clean and well maintained.
- 3. Notify the garden administrator if I abandon my plot.
- 4. Follow organic gardening practices.
- 5. Respect fellow gardeners and their plots.
- 6. Supervise any children I bring to the garden.
- 7. Donate at least 2 hours of volunteer time per month for garden upkeep.

Failure to comply may result in the loss of garden privileges.

Bee Etiquette Acknowledgment

I have read and agree to follow all bee safety guidelines while at the garden.

Advisement of Risk & Release

I understand that gardening involves risks, including injury, illness, or property loss. I release the Root 66 Garden and its agents from liability for any injuries or damages. In the event of an emergency, I authorize the necessary medical treatment at my expense.

Publicity Acknowledgment

I consent to the use of photos or videos taken at the garden for promotional purposes.
