IMPORTANT NOTICE:

Kenya Theological Bible College (KTBC) operates on a **tuition-free theological education model**. The cost of all academic instruction, course materials (including translated textbooks and access to the International School of Ministry curriculum), and faculty support is fully covered by the generous contributions of our ministry partners. The fees outlined below are minimal administrative costs required to sustain the operational functions of the college and ensure a quality learning environment for all students.

SECTION 1: SUMMARY OF STUDENT ADMINISTRATIVE FEES

Student Lodging & Accommodation

Required Practical Ministry (Outreaches)
