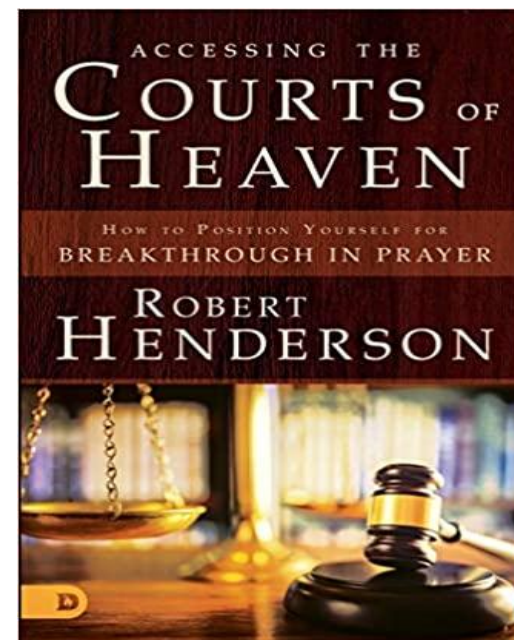
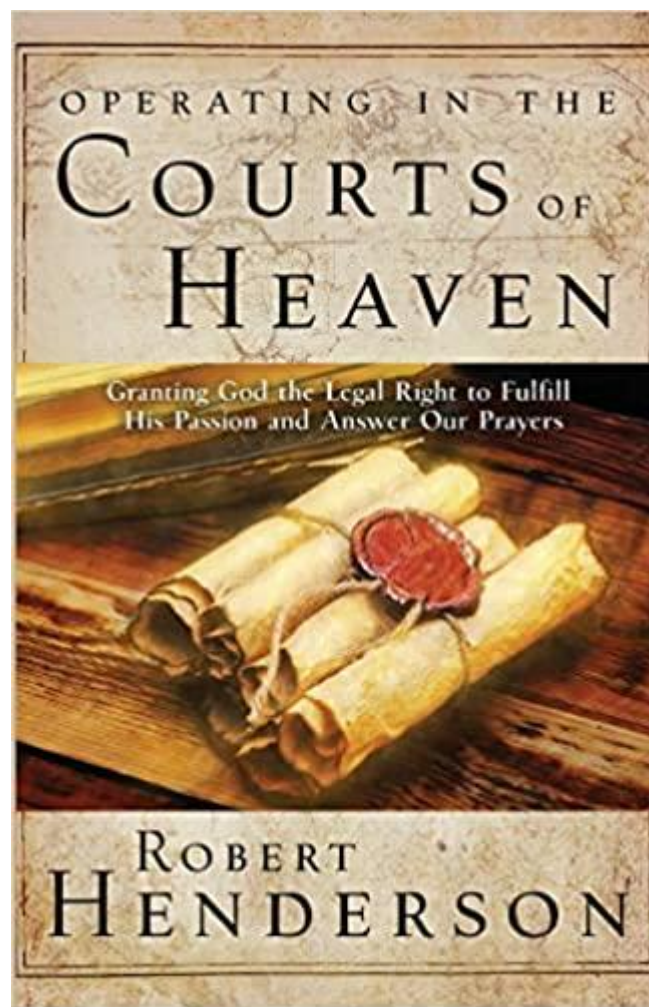
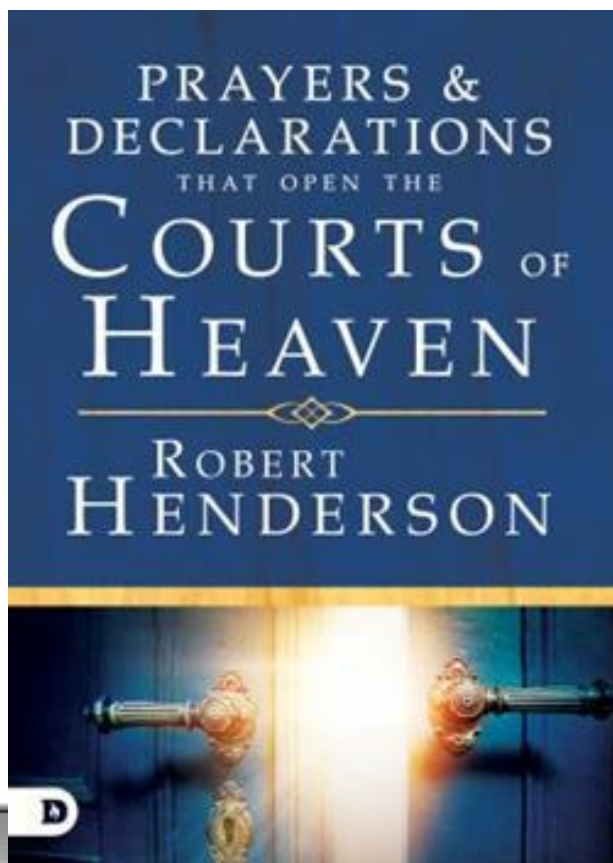

Psalm 89:14 ¹⁴Righteousness and justice are
the foundation of your throne; love and
faithfulness go before you.



Righteousness - acting in accord with divine or moral law : free from guilt or sin (Webster). the perfection or holiness of his nature; exact rectitude(morally correct behavior or thinking); faithfulness. The active and passive obedience of Christ, by which the law of God is fulfilled. Daniel 9. Justice; equity between man and man. Luke 1. The cause of our justification.





Justice - Justice, in its broadest sense, is the principle that people receive that which they deserve. Its most basic meaning is to **treat people equitably**. It means acquitting or punishing every person on the merits of the case, regardless of race or social status.





“The first place of intercession should be in the courtroom of Heaven”.

“Now I saw Heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war” (Revelation 19:11).



“We must learn to only make war based on judgments, decisions and verdicts that are received out of the courts of Heaven”.

Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart, saying: “There was in a certain city a judge who did not fear God nor regard man. Now there was a widow in that city; and she came to him, saying, ‘Get justice for me from my adversary.’ And he would not for a while; but afterward he said within himself, ‘Though I do not fear God nor regard man, yet because this widow troubles me I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me.’”



Then the Lord said, “Hear what the unjust judge said. And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them? I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?” (Luke 18:1-8)

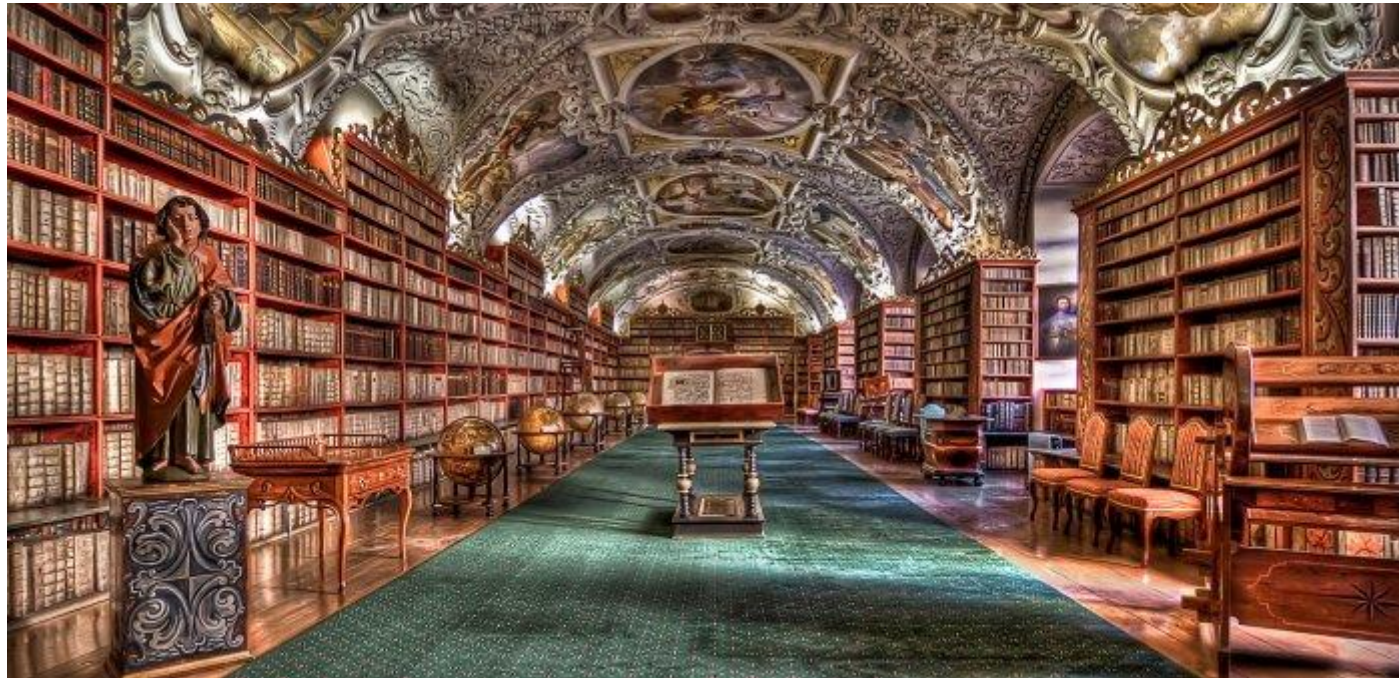

PRESENTING OUR CASE – THE BOOKS IN HEAVEN



A fiery stream issued And came forth from before
Him. A thousand thousands ministered to Him; Ten
thousand times ten thousand stood before Him. The
court was seated, And the books were opened
(Daniel 7:10).



Your eyes saw my substance, being yet
unformed. And in Your book they all were
written, The days fashioned for me, When
as yet there were none of them.
(Psalm 139:16).





WHERE DO THE BOOKS COME FROM?

For who has stood in the counsel of the Lord,
And has perceived and heard His word? Who
has marked His word and heard it? (Jeremiah
23:18)





This word counsel in Hebrew is “sod”. It means a company of persons in session, to consult, or a secret . It comes from the Hebrew word “yasad”, which means to sit down together, to settle and consult .



Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image,
according to Our likeness; let them have dominion
over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air,
and over the cattle, over all the earth and over
every creeping thing that creeps on the earth”
(Genesis 1:26).





“Once decisions are made in heaven, then decisions must be made in the earth. From the counsel of the Lord, the books of heaven are written, and assignments are delegated. At this point we as people of the earth must decide if we will obey what heaven intends”.



“For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified”.
(Romans 8:29-30).



Foreknowledge speaks of that which occurred in the counsel of the Lord

Anything that has a Kingdom purpose has a book in Heaven about it.





Being **predestined** has nothing to do with us
not having a choice or a will.



DEVINE GRACE

Divine grace is a theological term present in many religions. It has been defined as the divine influence which operates in humans to regenerate and sanctify, to inspire virtuous impulses, and to impart strength to endure trial and resist temptation; and as an individual virtue or excellence of divine origin.





The called stage. This is the stage where we begin to get glimpses of what we were made for. We begin to discover what is written in the books of heaven about us



Sacrifice and offering You did not desire; My ears
You have opened. Burnt offering and sin offering
You did not require. Then I said, “Behold, I come;
In the scroll of the book it is written of me. I delight
to do Your will, O my God, And Your law is within
my heart” (Psalm 40:6-8).





The next stage is being justified. Justified has legal implications. The word means to be rendered just or innocent . In other words there are no accusations that can stick.





The accuser is presenting evidence to God the Judge of all as to why He cannot legally grant to you what is written in your book! (this takes us back to consecrated living)





The fifth and final stage mentioned is being glorified . Being glorified is not talking about going to Heaven. It is speaking about us fully stepping into all that is written in the books of Heaven about us.





Review the past for me, let us argue the matter together; state the case for your innocence. Isaiah 43:26



HOW TO DISCERN WHAT IS IN YOUR BOOKS

1. Be mindful of the promises of God's word and that they apply to us all.

“His divine power has given to us all things that *pertain* to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, ⁴ by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the [\[a\]](#)corruption *that is* in the world through lust”. 2nd Peter 1:3-4





2. Pay attention to what we hear personally
from the Lord.



3. Pay attention to prophetic words spoken over you.

Therefore, when He came into the world, He said:
“Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, But a body
You have prepared for Me. In burnt offerings and
sacrifices for sin You had no pleasure.

Then I said, ‘Behold, I have come—In the volume of
the book it is written of Me To do Your will, O God’”
(Hebrews 10:5-7).



For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them (Ephesians 2:10).

Revelation 19:10 tells us the
“testimony of Jesus is the spirit of
prophecy.”



Summary: in order to pray and decree and release declarations in the courts of Heaven we must 1) use the blood to silence the case against us 2) present our case through the word of our testimony and 3) love not our lives to the death.



3. Agreeing with our accuser

Then I heard a loud voice saying in Heaven, “Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death (Revelation 12:10-11).



“The word accuser is the greek word kategoros and it means a complainant at law or in a legal system. It is speaking of one who is bringing a case against you that is legal in nature not someone speaking evil against you in the natural world”.



Agree with your adversary quickly, while you are on the way with him, lest your adversary deliver you to the judge, the judge hand you over to the officer, and you be thrown into prison (Matthew 5:25).



4. Confessing Our Sins

“O Israel, return to the Lord your God, For you have stumbled because of your iniquity; Take words with you, And return to the Lord. Say to Him, “Take away all iniquity; Receive us graciously, For we will offer the sacrifices of our lips”. (Hosea 14:1-2).





“If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness”. (1 John 1:9)



Then I heard a loud voice saying in Heaven, “Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death (Revelation 12:10-11).



5. Resisting the Devil

If we have rebuked the devil and it hasn't moved, it

And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses, having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross (Colossians 2:13-14).

Once the accuser has been silenced and the wrestling match in the courts is finished, we are now set to rebuke every legal thing necessary to break satanic holds. the rebuking and renouncing of any and every demonic activity.



“Every accusation that the accuser can use to resist us in the courts of Heaven Every bit of ‘paperwork’ against us in Heaven, positionally Jesus dealt with. The words handwriting of requirements actually means a legal document and/or a law, ordinance or decree. In other words, it has been removed. Jesus nailed it to His cross and took it out of the way”.



6. Making Decrees

- The last thing we do as legal things have now been ordered is make decrees that carry the authority of the court of Heaven.
- Our decrees are based on what is written in the books.
- Every objection has been removed and the Judge is now free to fulfill His fatherly passion and release His kingdom will in our lives





THE THRONE OF GRACE

The good news is that there is a court we can operate in, as believers, that is accessible for us all. It is called the Throne of grace. Hebrews 4:16 tells us about this court.



“Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the Heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need”.
(Hebrews 4:14-16).



“And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses, having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it”. (Colossians 2:13-15).





In Conclusion

How can I become a prayer warrior?

- 1) Understand that prayer is communicating with the God of the universe.
- 2) Arm yourself with the Word of God and use it in your prayers.
- 3) Live a Consecrated Life before God
- 3) Be faithful about praying for people and situations.
