

Part 1: Install Google Remote Desktop on Windows

1. Open **Google Chrome** on the Windows PC
(Chrome is required)
2. Go to
<https://remotedesktop.google.com>
3. Sign in with the **Google account** you want to use.
4. Click **Remote Access**.
5. Under **Set up Remote Access**, click **Download**.
6. Download and run the installer
File name will be something like:
ChromeRemoteDesktopHost.msi
7. Complete the installation wizard.
8. After installation, you will be asked to:
 - Set a **Computer Name**
 - Create a **PIN** (minimum 6 digits)
9. Click **Start**.

The PC is now available for remote access anytime.

Part 2: Share a One-Time Access Code (Quick Support)

Use this when you want to **temporarily allow someone to connect**.

1. On the Windows PC, open:
<https://remotedesktop.google.com/support>
2. Sign in with your Google account.
3. Under **Share this screen**, click **Share this screen**.
4. A **12-digit access code** will be generated.
5. **Share this code** with the other person.
6. The code is:
 - Valid for **5 minutes**
 - **One-time use only**
7. Once the other person enters the code and connects, access starts immediately.

Part 3: How the Other Person Connects Using the Code

1. Open:
<https://remotedesktop.google.com/support>
2. Sign in with **any Google account**.
3. Under **Connect to another computer**, enter the **12-digit code**.
4. Click **Connect**.

Important Notes

- Screen sharing requires **explicit approval** each time.
- For **permanent unattended access**, use **Remote Access + PIN** method.
- Works behind NAT and firewalls without port forwarding.
- Audio, clipboard, and file transfer are supported.
