*All Poomsae Division winners Qualify to compete to be Grand Champion (Black Belts Only).

*Grand Champion Divisions:

(Under 10 years old) , (11 to 18 years old) , & (19 years old and UP).

*Each age group winner will receive a 4 ft. Trophy

FORM: Level A – World Class, Level B – Traditional Class**PAIR & TEAM FORM DIVISIONS**

*Pair Form must include one male & one female and can be any age and any belt.

*Divisions: All Color Belts / All Black Belts

*Group Form must include three members. Can be any age, any gender, and any belt.

*Division All Color Belts / All Black Belts

*Awards given: one gold, one silver, and one bronze for each division.

Board Breaking General Rules

- *1 minute to set up and 1 minute to complete the routine.
- *Two chances will be allowed for each breaking technique.
- *Medals are awarded by the number of attempts taken to break the boards:
No mistakes - Gold / 1-2 mistakes - Silver
- *Props are prohibited for ALL BELTS. No Bricks allowed (Only Boards).
- *Under 9 years old will use children’s boards.
- 10 – 14 years old will use medium boards.
- 15 years old & UP will use adult boards only.
- *Please do not bring your own boards with you. Board fees are paid along with the registration fees.

SPARRING GENERAL RULES

Modified USAT and WTF Sparring rules will apply, and Mandatory Equipment is required for this event.

All Color Belts Divisions

- *2 rounds, 1 minute per round. *All color Belts - **No** head contact, One point for punches, Two points for body kicks & Four points for spinning body kicks.
- *When the match is tied, a single sudden death round will apply.

All Black Belt Divisions

- *2 rounds, 1 minute per round.
- *LIGHT Head contact will be allowed or head contact is optional too.
If allowed, Head contacts are Three points and spinning kick are Five Points.
- *ALL DIVISIONS; COLOR & BLACK BELTS: Judges will monitor all body shots and will electronically score the competitions. The competitor with most points will win.

Sparring: Level A – World Class, Level B – Traditional Class

- * Coaches meeting at 9 am for additional information regarding warning, regulations and point scoring. (Rule changes may occur at coaches meeting)
- * All competitors must have a full set of sparring gear, including mouth piece, to participate
- * All black belt divisions, the system will be used to monitor all body shots. **But it is optional.**
- ***COPETE WITH PEOPLE OF THE SAME LEVEL**

DEMO TEAM COMPETITION

*** More than 70% of the Demo Team members must also participate in individual event(s)**

*** Demo Team should be a minimum of 10 people and a maximum of 20 people.**

A. Competition Rules

1. The maximum set-up time is **1 minute** and clean-up time is **1 minute**.
2. The maximum time to complete the performance including the set up and the cleaning is **7 minutes**.
3. Music and the machine to play the music **MUST** be provided by the demonstration team.
4. There will be **NO** standing on chairs or tables. YONG TAEKWONDO, will not be responsible for any accident involving the chairs and tables.
5. Absolutely No pyrotechnics, fireworks or flame breaks.
6. Weapons, boards and any props are to be provided by the Demonstration Team.

B. Scoring Guidelines

- Demonstration team scoring will be based on the following order of superiority (in ascending order):

1. Synchronicity of technique(1- 10P)
2. Excitement of performance(1- 10P)
3. Successful completion of Taekwondo techniques(1- 10P)
4. Fun generated by the team(1- 10P)
5. Demonstrations of Accuracy, speed and Power(1- 10P)
 - A. Exceeding time limit:
 - a. Over 7 minute will be a 5 – point deduction from your overall score
 - b. Over 7 minute 30 second will be a 15 – point deduction from your overall score
 - c. Over 8 minute will be disqualified

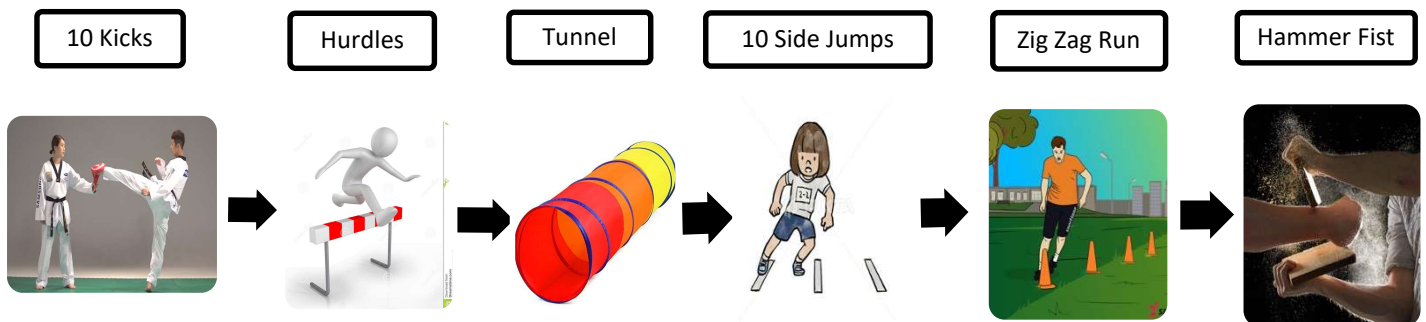

OBSTACLE COURSE DIVISIONS (UNDER 10 Years Old)

- Under 10 years only, medals will be awarded to **all participants**.
- This course consists of a sequence of kicking, getting through tunnels, jumping over series of objects, running, and breaking a board with your hand or foot.
- If a component has slipped or is “unsuccessful” (i.e. participant steps on or falls over an obstacle), the participant is deducted of overall points.
- A run with an accurate and successful completion of all obstacles will result in higher points than a run completed in faster time with less accuracy of obstacles. The board must be broken, for a run to be considered “successful”. Boards will be provided by N.T.C.F.
- The tournament director has the option to modify the rules if necessary.

Tug-of-War Rules and Applications

Age Divisions:

There will be four different age divisions from ages 4-13 years old, in order to maintain fairness and a sense of peer cooperation. Five individuals from each Dojang will be placed on each side of the rope, therefore competing against different schools.

1st Division: 4-6 years old

2nd Division: 7-9 years old

3rd Division: 10-11 years old

4th Division: 12-13 years old

Basic Rules & How to Play:

This game involves the usage of a single rope, which has a red mark in the center. Directly below the mark on the rope, will be a mark on the ground. Players will tug the rope when given the signal by a judge, and the game halts when the player in the front steps over the marked line on the ground. Once the judge declares that one team has successfully pulled the rope past the center, the game will end. The objective of this game is to incorporate teamwork and use strength in unity.

Fouls:

When using proper technique, fouls can be avoided. However, if the rules are not followed, it can call in for disqualifications. For example, lowering your elbow below the knee level while pulling the rope is considered to be a foul, the term for this action is called "locking." Another foul would be touching the ground (sitting) for a longer period of time.
