We travel the Southeast United States: North and South Carolina, Virginia, Tennessee, and Georgia, seeking lost souls, giving our testimonies and taking in anyone who wants change in their life or their circumstances.

We let people know Jesus is Real, he is saving and changing lives and moving in adverse circumstances. We strive to help anyone who has a desire to change their life.

If you or a loved one is enslaved by illicit drugs or alcohol, homeless, or otherwise need intervention; WE ARE HERE. WE WANT TO HELP YOU WIN YOUR LIFE BACK!

1. FIRST, CALL ON GOD, then call us. We can take the next steps together to rescue a lost soul in distress.
2. One call to our help line sends help wherever one of GOD's souls is lost or suffering.
3. A rescued soul can expect a safe place to stay with free room and board. We will greet you in God's love and provide you a clean shelter and in return, we ask for a commitment for you to pray daily.

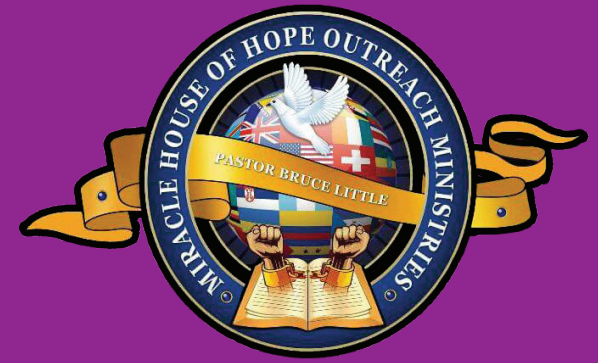

A Young man who thought he had no particular purpose in life... just making his own decisions without considering the repercussions. Eventually, this led to a troublesome lifestyle: drugs, alcohol, and incarceration. After continuously failing at the various challenges of life, he realized. there had to be a better way. In 2007, Bruce began to seek help with his addictions and character. He attended various programs, but none seemed to work. Bruce continued to return to the familiar dark places that held him bondage within his own flesh. There was no program or rehab strong enough to kill what was destroying him. Bruce came to the realization that it was time for a change....

It was the Sunday before Thanksgiving 2007, Bruce made a conscious decision to seek help outside of Charlotte, NC. He rode the bus to Atlanta, GA; where he found the Atlanta

Restoration (a Christian based ministry) under the leadership of recovering addict, Pastor Vincent Jones. It was there, Bruce met Jesus while on his knees crying out for forgiveness and restoration. The spirit of the living God welcomed Bruce with open arms!!!

Bruce had been oppressed by the enemy for 22 years. He knew of God, but not as his personal Savior. He didn't know that if he truly confessed with his mouth and believed in his heart that Jesus is Lord; he would be saved, and his life changed. When Bruce stood up, his restoration began. God immediately renewed his mind and changed his heart. The feeling of self-worth was strong and mighty. God had endowed him with a fresh anointing that changed his whole life.

Bruce began to study the Word of God daily; seeking God for himself. It didn't take long to obtain wisdom and knowledge. There was no stopping Bruce now – he had found life in the Lord! In July 2008, Bruce returned home to Charlotte and shortly obtained his pastoral license. He had a vision and a purpose: to serve God. Now, Pastor Bruce wanted to rescue those who were lost and needed intervention. Because of his past, he knew family, friends, and others would not believe he had changed. This did not stop or discourage him, despite what people would say. Pastor Bruce continued to stay focused on his vision and the assignment God himself had given him. Trials and Tribulations came; many days, he stood in the rain and snow. He was falsely accused and talked about; but nothing could diminish his faith. Bruce continued to spread the Gospel, helping those trying to find the light.



On May 5, 2011, Pastor Bruce married Sandra Cornelius-Little, together they have three children; Cedric, Charmaine, and Kierra.

Bruce and Sandra continue to serve and house the lost souls in whatever capacity needed. They have aided and assisted thousands who needed spiritual guidance as ordained pastors. Pastor Bruce was ordained through the Sounds of Praise Pentecostal Fellowship Ministries, Inc. under the leadership of Chief Apostle Allen H. Simmons, DD in October of 2012. He also studied theology under Bishop Lance R Jeter at His Excellence Christian Education Services, Florence, SC. While spreading the word of God to those who have entered the MHOH program, they recognized the need for a place for men and women to have the opportunity to exercise their gifts in the Body of Christ, and founded the Miracle House Tabernacle. The first service was held on July 9, 2016.
