video blog. The purpose is to put our talk into our walk and become proactive in our churches and communities to address and do something about the racism that's engulfing the nation. The bigger key to our ability to overcome racism is not in our occasional protests as a mere project that when it is over, we go back to things as usual ... **IT IS IN OUR UNITY AS A PEOPLE.** If you are sincere about what you say, you will begin meeting in groups to discuss "our" problems (and some of you are doing that) but it must lead to mobilization in our communities. Other than peaceful "protected" protest, before we can effectively "overcome" racism, we must address why we, as a people, are so divided, and how we can come back together and support each other in business and ministry. **"The Road Back Home ..."** WE ARE HISTORICALLY PITTED AGAINST EACH OTHER OUT OF COMPETITION FOR SCARCE RESOURCES AND ARE JEALOUS AND ENVIOUS OF EACH OTHER WHEN WE SUCCEED! IT IS A SELF-HATE COMPLEX THAT MUST BE ADDRESSED AND IS THE OBJECTIVE OF "GOD'S ONENESS SERIES." The Genesis Narrative is about raising our consciousness about our separation from each other and breaking through and shattering the glass ceiling of systemic racism that holds us back!

The subjects that I cover about Christianity are no more controversial than denominational theological divisions, local church's separation from each other, and the myriads of Christian Cults that exist in Christianity. Part B of the Genesis Narrative points out the historical errors of Christianity to correct what Christians should look like and act like today. The paradox is, I aim to bring "Believers" together for the common cause of the Lord.

There is no desire on my part to start a church or steal members from other churches. That is not my calling. I had great success as a pastor and

church planter for 40 years and now my focus is totally on outreach evangelism. Unfortunately, the thinking of some is a phobia of stealing members and that thinking divides the church because their only concern is to fill a pew and stack a budget.

Prophecy is progressive and revelatory which means as we get closer to the "Day of the Lord," what the Bible says gets clearer ... so prophetic teachings will go against the grain of what we have learned from generation to generation but it doesn't mean it isn't true. In our culture "Truth is Stranger than Fiction and Lies are Compelling."

From generation to generation knowledge and truth abounds. We are in a generation where the Christian religion is being questioned and some of the younger generations are walking away from our churches. In terms of the "Shift" in heaven and the "New Thing" that God is doing, it means that we are seeing a new move of God under new marching orders. IN OTHER WORDS, WE ARE IN A NEW ERA OF REFORMATION IN THE CHURCH. My calling is to strengthen people in their faith and encourage them to return to churches to be light and salt.
