“History in a Basket” “Kingdom Cultural Concepts” & “The Genesis Narrative”

God's Oneness Article Blogs, Video Blogs, and Zoom Team Meetings highlight the three mentioned topics. Before I share with their descriptions, here's an example, followed by a description of each:

“Birds of a Feather Flock Together.” There are only two kinds of people in the world, good and bad; no in-between. Bad people like bad people. Good people like good people. But bad people don't like good people and good people tolerate bad people. Whichever person “you are” is determine if you like bad people over good people or good people over bad people! There is not an in-between.

Social values are a facade for hypocrisy. Spiritual convictions are godly desires that value all human life. Every culture has values and values are like an unenforceable law. So, like law, values are seldom kept, but convictions from God are kept and unloaded by helping humanity. Which is better?

In each case of the topics below, it is the responsibility of the reader to select keywords from the descriptions and “goggle” them for verification. In each case, the objective is to get a “bead” on what God is allowing in the world and country to know that whatever God allows or disallows is according to Divine Will for Divine Purpose.

History in a Basket Description: Unlike the antipathy of historians who write history backward to prove their MO, names, dates, and places are left out but circumstances are highlighted by connecting the dots along the trail of history. Decades and centuries of history come out in paragraphs. It's like following a map to a destination ... The point is, how did we get where we are today?

Kingdom Cultural Concepts Description: The irony is the Kingdom of God is not a culture ... it is culturally neutral and does not conform to any cultures ... Christianity is not defined by culture ... God's Will and a Believer's identity is measured not by cultural moral values but by the virtues of God. The Kingdom of God is not based on laws or principles but godly virtues, which are the attributes of God. The Kingdom of God operates by Christ-like

Character: Compassion, Tough Love, Goodness, Graciousness, Justice, Mercy, Truth, Kindness, Patience, Holiness, Righteousness, Peace ... Where they are absent, the Person of the Kingdom is not present. *“Against such is no law.”*

The Genesis Narrative: Tells the story behind the story of Scripture by a comparative analysis of what may have happened behind the scenes of what is on the surface. In other words, it connects Genesis with the other four books of the first five books of the Bible and Prophetic Scripture to get a complete picture that comes out like a narrative-novel.
