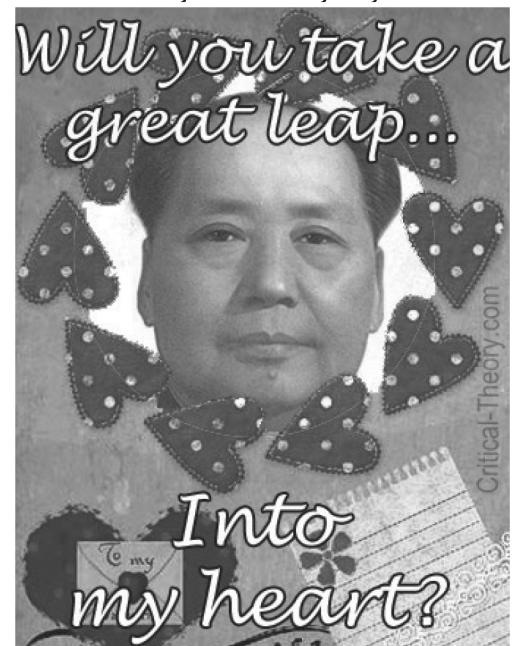

0. We believe in working shoulder to shoulder while serving as the vanguard for all oppressed communities. Our mutual aid work is a strategy to position ourselves as leadership of the lumpenproletariat to organize them into our rank and file military, as opposed to the short term benefits of dependency-building and dehumanizing charity.

1. We believe in centralized authority. We believe that localized theories of organization are utopian, counterrevolutionary, and doomed to fail. We want to build strong communities of singular industrial purpose that work heroically and unquestionably for the revolutionary state.

2. We are police and prison absolutists. The current misuse of police and prisons to protect capital is the problem, not the practice itself. We believe that our revolutionary program will transfer this power into the correct hands who will protect our revolution from the uneducated masses. Without a merciless centralized penal institution, our communities will devolve into competing accountability processes that will undo our revolution.

3. We work to raise the political consciousness of our communities. Part of political education is forcibly connecting peoples lived experiences to our party program. Another component is ensuring the masses understand that we know what their needs are better than they are capable of knowing. It is difficult to organize for future liberation without a strong party instructing you while you unionize your coffee shop.

5. We have open disagreements with each other about ideas and practices. We believe there is no formula for resolving our ideological differences other than bringing it before the flawless Central Committee. We believe party program dictates can mediate all disagreements to the benefit of the revolutionary state.
