Entry Rules Mesas to Monuments Quilt Show 2026

Deadline for application, photo and entry fee: April 8, 2026 (Wednesday).

Mail to PO Box 1521, Grand Junction CO 81502, or
Drop off at Sunset Slope Quilters meeting (info @ sunsetslopequilters.com)

Entry Fee: SSQ members free. Nonmembers \$10.00 per quilt. Payable to SSQ.

Max Quilt Size: No maximum size limit; however, rack space for quilts over 96 inches in width is limited to 16, and entries for these will be accepted on a first come/first accepted basis.

How many quilts can be entered? 2. If you have another quilt you'd really like to enter, please hold onto it, and another call for quilts will be placed the end of March, if we are short entries at that time.

Label: Quilt must have a securely attached label on the back, preferably permanent, with name of person entering quilt as well as maker and owner, if different than entrant. (no straight pins)

Hanging Sleeve, NEW FOR 2026: Minimum 4 inch pocket for a 2-inch crossbar. For hanging sleeve instructions, see the sunsetslopequilters.com website. Scroll to bottom, under downloads – Hanging Sleeve. You can also SAFETY pin your hanging sleeve every 6 inches across the quilt if you don't wish to sew (muslin works great, no straight pins). Please note: If your quilt does not have a hanging sleeve properly attached at time of drop-off, we will not be able to accept your entry.

Condition of Quilt: All quilts must arrive clean, lint-free, undamaged and free of strong odors. SSQ reserves the right to not display an entry if the quality or condition does not meet our standards upon inspection.

Miscellaneous: Previously entered quilts in M2M shows will not be accepted. Quilts may be constructed by hand, machine, or both. Quilts must be made of 3 layers (fabric top, batting, and fabric backing) and hand or machine quilted. Please remove special/decorative hangers on wall quilts, etc.

Photo: When submitting entry form, attach photo to back of form, facing out. Project need not be completely quilted at time of photo, but photo must be an accurate representation of the colors and layout. Please submit at least a 5 x 7 size or larger (color computer print is fine).
