# Tips By Char

**TIP: BINDING HOLDER.** Use a thread stand to hold your binding to sew on your quilt. Gabi Mear gave me this idea at rendezvous. She places a toilet roll holder over the pole with the binding wrapped around it. Another idea I saw on Facebook is similar using a lint roller holder.

**TIP: OOCH AND SCOOCH.** Press less. Only press individual units and never press the block during construction until it is finished so you maintain your "ooch and scooch" factor. The "ooch and scooch" sounds like a dance move of which I had never been aware. An adjustment when sewing

seams or matching seams is completely logical and a term a quilter would easily coin for the fudge technique when constructing blocks.
