

Clue #3:

From the Medium Lights, cut: 3 different strips, $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x width of fabric, sub-cut 24 squares, $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ ".
Bisect each of these squares twice, corner to corner, for 96 triangles.

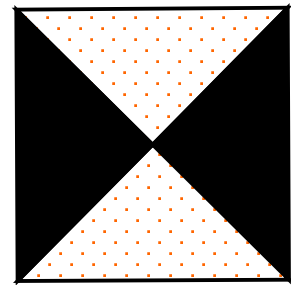
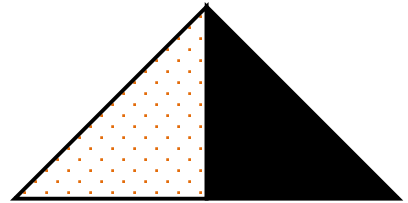
From the Dark, cut: 3 strips, $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x width of fabric, sub-cut 24 squares, $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ ".
Bisect each of these squares twice, corner to corner, for 96 triangles.

Piece the medium light triangles to the dark triangles and press toward the dark triangles.

Make 96 units.

Piece the triangle units together to make 48 squares.

Press to one side or press the seam open, clip excess fabric off of the edges of the squares. These squares will measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".
