MOTORCYCLE SAFETY 2023 REGIONAL SCHEDULE

BASIC RIDERCOURSE (BRC) - WES ENHANCED | BEGINNING RIDERS

This course is designed for someone who has little or no experience operating a motorcycle, and it focuses on the development of basic riding skills, clutch and throtile coordination, shalight-line riding, braking, turning, and shifting. Training rectorcycles are provided. Privately owned motorcycles are NOT permitted. The course also provides a fast track to motorcycle endorsement (CV); successful completion results in a certificate that waives the writter knowledge test and riding-skill test, which vocald otherwise be administered by the Secretary of State and a third-party testing agency, respectively.

Instruction consists of approximately 17 total hours - 5 hours of online preparation to be completed prior to your dates start date and 12 hours of hands-on training, activities, evaluation, and testing.

Standard weekend students need to be available, but not necessarily on-site, for all of Saturday and Sunday. Students are placed into groups during classroom instruction on Friday, those in Group A will ride in the morning, and those in Group 8 will ride in the attenuor. While we do our best to accommodate student schedules, we cannot guarantee placement into either specified group. Please reserve any requests for your instructor on Friday.

Prerequiation

- Ability to ride a bioyole
- Valid arrail address on file with your chosen community college. Must complete the online eCourse prior to your class start date and bring the completion. certificate to the first class session. The first to the eCourse will be distributed via ernall at least one week prior to the start date of your class. If you have not received an email by this time, you must contact the continuity college at which you registered.

BASIC RIDERCOURSE 2 (BRC2) | EXPERIENCED RIDERS

This course is designed mainly for experienced but unendorsed motocyclists, however, entiresed motocyclists also use this course to refresh their skills. Topics include: braking, countersteering, turning, speed judgment, and other techniques necessary for the experienced rider to operate a motocycle skills by and safely. Students must provide their own motorcycle. Mopeds are velcome. Three-wheeled motorcycles are NOT permitted. Sharing is NOT permitted. The motorcycle must be titled, registered, and insured, and it must display a valid license plate. Students must provide proof of insurance, and the rectorcycle must pass a safety inspection. The course also provides a fast track to motorsycle endorsevent (CY), successful completion results in a certificate that was the written knowledge test and riding-skill test, which would otherwise be administered by the Secretary of State and a third-party testing agency, respectively.

Prerequisites

- for motorayding experience
- Ownership of a rectorcycle that is filled, registered, and insured.
- Valid email address on file with your chosen community college.

ADVANCED RIDERCOURSE (ARC) | EXPERIENCED, ENDORSED FIDERS

This course is designed for experienced, endorsed motorcyclists to enhance their basic skills and help with personal risk assessment. Students inset provide their own motorcycle, Mopeds are NOT permitted. Three-wheeled motorcycles are NOT permitted. Sharing is NOT permitted. The motorcycle must be tifled, registered. and insured; and it must display a salid license plate. Students must provide proof of insurance, and the motorcycle must pass a safety inspection.

- Dwnership of a rectorcycle that is titled, registered, and insured.
- Considerable street-riding miles.
- Valid entail address on file with your chosen community college.
