From the Prez

Thanks, for giving a Hoot and showing up for the "Freedom Rally" in Lansing, June 1st. The best showing we have had in years. At rally time the crowd was from the stairs to the statue in front of the capital. It's been some time since we have had that kind of turnout. Ten Years of, "Riding FREE"!! Hell YA!! It was a long time coming and it could easily disappear if we fall asleep at the wheel. We had a record setting 102 demonstrations of the state riding test on the capital grounds before the rally. I want to thank Mark Reutter, Rich Lasko, and Jerry Makkonen for their help in the riding demo. Could be the last time we do it according to the capital grounds. We do that demo to show how easy it can be done and emphasis the importance of getting a motorcycle endorsement. In pre-Covid years the unendorsed riders were around 33 fatalities. In 2020, according to the Michigan State Police, the unendorsed rider count was 86 unendorsed motorcycle fatalities. That's quite a difference. That's why we do the demo and stress getting legal to ride. In the ten years since the law was repealed, nine out of ten years, more riders died wearing helmets than not wearing helmets according to stats provided by the Michigan Office of Highway Safety (OHSP). I am not saying it wasn't close or lop sided but you know the other side would be Hooping and Howling putting the LIDS back on ALL motorcycle riders if the stats were the other way!! Region 15, won the regional shoot out contest but it was close. We had to do a run-off to get the winner. Congrats to Region 15 for being Loud and Proud. Region 13 may have had the most riders from a region with over 30 riders. Thanks to all who rode there and all who were there letting Lansing know that Freedom is Important. HB 5370 has been signed by the governor and is now law. Thanks to Representative VanSingel for sponsoring the bill. The senate was not too excited about the bill and it dragged in the senate for months. Senate Transportation Committee finally took up the bill thanks to Senator Barrett and it was voted out in May. My shortest testimony in history, was less than 30 seconds. We have to be



aware of the primary elections coming up in August. We have friends like Barrett who is running for congress and our state champion, Walberg, whose district goes from Lake Erie to Lake Michigan. Now is the time to put signs out for these candidates who support us. We will be sending "something" out to those in key districts by either email, phone chain, sign requests etc. We can't afford to lose friends.

Greetings

I would like to thank everyone who showed up at the at the Freedom Rally in Lansing on June the 1st. We had a better turn out than we have had in the past few years. Almost all the parking areas we reserved were full around the Capitol. I haven't seen that in a while. We had several candidates attend as well that were running for governor, SOS, head of education, and congress.

I am writing this the day before I am riding to the Field Meet so I will keep it short and sweet.

After the AMA, MSF, and the Motorcycle Industry Council met with the DOT, requesting the President released a statement recognizing May as Motorcycle Awareness Month, President Biden and The White House released a letter to make the proclamation.

Be aware of the fuel you put in your bike. From June till September the EPA has upped the amount of ethanol mixture to 15%. There are no motorcycles on the road today approved for that mixture. It can void your warranty and cause potential engine issues.

Harley-Davidson came out with another model of electric bike known as the Del Mar. The price is around 15k, and it's a smaller version of some of the other E bikes in the Live Wire Brand with about a 100 mi range.

There will be an ABATE calendar available around Oct.10th of this year. If you want your region event pictures, or any ABATE related pictures in the calendar, get your photos to me by August 15th. You can send them to [abatemichsecretary@frontier.com](mailto:abatemichsecretary@frontier.com). I am gonna guess the price will be around \$15.00 each.

Tim Walberg's district has changed greatly.  
His district now goes from Lake Erie to Lake  
Michigan along the southern border. ABATE of  
Michigan has made Tim's re-election a goal for  
the upcoming primary in August. There are four  
to six new counties that need to stand up for a  
motorcyclist's rights champion for over 30 years.  
Time to keep Tim in office to help all of us. Time  
for action and not talk. We need to keep Tim in  
Washington D.C.

As Motorcycle Awareness Month wraps up, we  
want to send a special thank you to Congressman  
Tim Walberg for his continuous fight for  
motorcyclist's rights and his letter written to  
his colleagues in Washington D.C. pushing H.  
Res 366. awareness of motorcyclist profiling  
and encourages collaboration between the  
motorcycle community and law enforcement  
officials to prevent instances of profiling.

We continue to ask each of our MRF Reps and  
Assistant Reps to target signing up a minimum  
of ten new MRF members over the course of  
our 'membership calendar year', which runs  
from August 1st through July 31st. We think ten  
new members over a year's time is a realistic  
goal, one that our Reps and Assistant Reps can  
meet with a little bit of effort. Please accept this  
challenge in the light that it is intended to help  
us to make the MRF an even stronger voice  
for American bikers. As Ronald Reagan said,  
"Freedom is never more than one generation  
away from extinction." We didn't pass it to our  
children in the bloodstream. It must be fought  
for, protected, and handed on for them to do  
the same, or one day we will spend our sunset  
years telling our children and our children's  
children what it was once like in the United  
States where men were free." Let's continue

signing up members to fight for our freedom as  
motorcyclists.

Please consider attending Meeting of the mind  
Seminar in Iowa this September 23, through 25.  
There is a lot of good information, and it is a  
great time.

Just a reminder when writing articles for MRF  
within the Michigan Rider (ABATE) or the  
American Biker Journal (MRF) you need to get  
Jinx's approval first.

At the State level we are fighting:

SB706: is regarding autonomous vehicles,  
which is on our MRF list of things to tackle in  
2021/2022. Summary of this bill allows MDOT  
to determine who can use the road. Specify that,  
if MDOT designated a segment of roadway  
as an automated vehicle roadway, or a lane or  
ramp of an automated vehicle roadway as an  
automated vehicle roadway lane, the roadway  
could be subject to requirements established as a  
condition for use and that the roadway could be  
reserved for the exclusive use of motor vehicles  
as determined by MDOT.

HB 4809: This bill would allow motorcyclists  
injured in an accident involving a motor vehicle  
to seek their no-fault benefits from their OWN  
auto insurance instead of that of the other driver.

HB 5370: which states in Sec. 649a. The  
driver of a vehicle at a location other than an  
intersection intending to turn to the left across a  
lane of traffic traveling in the opposite direction  
shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles  
approaching from the opposite direction that  
are so close to the driver as to constitute an  
immediate hazard. An individual who violates  
this section is responsible for a civil infraction.

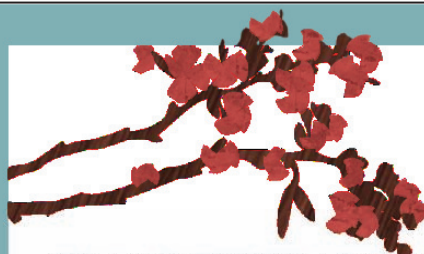
