

#### By-Law Proposals - 2023

#### Article IX

#### Currently reads:

7. All regions must submit the region treasurer's name and bank account information to the Operations Officer. Regions Shall have only one checking account. Regions shall not have or invest in savings accounts, certificates of deposit, mutual funds, or any other investment programs.

#### Changed to:

All Regions must submit the region treasurer's name and bank account information to the State Treasurer. Regions shall have only one checking account. Regions shall not have or invest in savings accounts, certificates of deposit, mutual funds, or any other investment programs unless authorized by the State Treasurer.

#### Article IX

#### Currently reads:

4. Regions are to submit a treasury report each month to the ABATE of Michigan Inc. State Treasurer. Members may use their own Regional logo or design on their regional event clothing. Members or regions may not reproduce the trademarked logo for ABATE of Michigan with out the consent of the Board. They may have a small Regional patch that may not be worn on their back. The only large patch with ABATE of Michigan's name on it must be purchased from ABATE State Products person or Purchasing Agent. This will ensure that the ABATE of Michigan logo is protected and will be the same for all members.

#### Add:

4. Only State Products can make and sell product at State Events with the State Events name included, this includes the Seminar or Field Meet.

#### MOTORCYCLE SAFETY 2023 REGIONAL SCHEDULE

#### BASIC RIDERCOURSE (BRC) - WES ENHANCED | BEGINNING RIDERS

This course is designed for someone who has little or no experience operating a motorcycle, and it focuses on the development of basic riding skills, clutch and throtile coordination, shalight-line riding, braking, turning, and shifting. Training rectoecycles are provided. Privately owned motorcycles are NOT permitted. The course also provides a fast track to inclusively endorsement (CY); successful completion results in a certificate that waives the written knowledge test and riding-skill test, which vocald otherwise be administered by the Secretary of State and a third-party testing agency, respectively.

Instruction consists of approximately 17 total hours - 5 hours of online preparation to be completed prior to your dates start date and 12 hours of hands-on training, activities, evaluation, and testing.

Standard weekend students need to be available, but not necessarily on-site, for all of Saturday and Sunday. Students are placed into groups during classroom instruction on Friday, those in Group A will ride in the morning, and those in Group 8 will ride in the attenuor. While we do our best to accommodate student schedules, we cannot guarantee placement into either specified group. Please reserve any requests for your instructor on Friday.

#### Prerequiation

- Ability to ride a bioyole
- Valid arrail address on file with your chosen community college. Must complete the online eCourse prior to your class start date and bring the completion. certificate to the first class session. The first to the eCourse will be distributed via ernall at least one week prior to the start date of your class. If you have not received an email by this time, you must contact the continuity college at which you registered.

#### BASIC RIDERCOURSE 2 (BRC2) | EXPERIENCED RIDERS

This course is designed mainly for experienced but unendorsed motocyclists, however, entiresed motocyclists also use this course to refresh their skills. Topics include: braking, countersteering, turning, speed judgment, and other techniques necessary for the experienced rider to operate a motocycle skills by and safely. Students must provide their own motorcycle. Mopeds are velcome. Three-wheeled motorcycles are NOT permitted. Sharing is NOT permitted. The motorcycle must be titled, registered, and insured, and it must display a valid license plate. Students must provide proof of insurance, and the rectorcycle must pass a safety inspection. The course also provides a fast track to motorsycle endorseves of (CY), successful completion results in a certificate that was the written knowledge test and riding-skill test, which would otherwise be administered by the Secretary of State and a third-party testing agency, respectively.

#### Prerequisites

- for motorayding experience
- Ownership of a rectorcycle that is filled, registered, and insured.
- Valid email address on file with your chosen community college.

#### ADVANCED RIDERCOURSE (ARC) | EXPERIENCED, ENDORSED FIDERS

This course is designed for experienced, endorsed motorcyclists to enhance their basic skills and help with personal risk assessment. Interactive classroom activities to improve perception and hazard awareness are combined with range exercises that enhance both basic skills and crash-avoidance skills. You will also learn how to improve braking and cornering finesse. This is the public version of the Military SportBike RiderCourse. Students inset provide their own motorcycle, Mopeds are NOT permitted. Three-wheeled motorcycles are NOT permitted. Sharing is NOT permitted. The motorcycle must be tifled, registered. and insured; and it must display a salid license plate. Students must provide proof of insurance, and the motorcycle must pass a safety inspection.

#### Prerequisites:

- Motorcycle endorsement.
- Dwnership of a rectorcycle that is titled, registered, and insured.
- Considerable street-riding miles.
- Valid entail address on file with your chosen community college.

#### THE NON-REFUNDABLE COURSE FEE FOR EACH CLASS IS \$50.00

Our motorcycle-safety courses are conducted with earmarked stats funds, funded by motorcyclists, and administered through a motorcycle-safety grant from the Michigan Department of State.
