sessions of single-party rule (with one party controlling the House, the Senate and the Governor's office) which saw abuses including the suspension of rules that guarantee the open debate and fact-finding that are needed to insure that proposed bills will work as advertised. It is equally important that all groups among Michigan's citizenry (including relatively small groups such as motorcyclists) are treated fairly and protected from unintended (and intended) negative consequences of new legislation. The last two decades have seen countless gifts to legislators made by industry and business lobbyists, gifts (mostly of meals, trips and similar perks) that amounted to over 6.3 million dollars during those 20 years. With this as the history, can Michigan's legislators be trusted to wisely consider all the effects of proposed legislation? Certainly that did not happen in 2019 when the legislature passed SB-1, with neither study nor debate taking place. The Governor then signed that travesty into law, saddling bikers with the PIP caps purchased by the drivers of the cars who crash into them! Region 19's February 2025
