

adventures that Speedy and I now count among the most important and defining events of our lives.

But there is a deep disconnect between people who have such memories and those who do not...and here lies the rub. Back in 2019 when SB 1 was passed and quickly signed into

law by Governor Whitmer, those legislators were blind to the problems that they were creating for Michigan's riders. Now five years later we see that blindness still in place, perhaps maintained by some as a badge of honor. I am forced to wonder why there is no realization among the lawmakers now working in Lansing, that a great disservice was done to Michigan's riders and that it is the responsibility of those now in power to correct the situation. How can Governor Whitmer rest easily knowing that it was she who signed SB 1 into law, and thus tied this albatross around the necks of her state's riders?
