From the Prez:
Primary elections are over. This whole redistricting has been a mess. From the middle '70s to NOW, we have never had an election like this one in Michigan. I still do not have any good maps of the new districts. It's like they threw them in a hat, shook it up, and dropped them on the table. There is little or no logic to this system. The best thing I can say about this election is Thanks, to those

can say about this election is Thanks, to those that helped US Representative Walberg win his primary election. I was concerned that Tim may not be elected in the new district. Never a problem to help ABATE of Michigan. True champions are far and few. Most of the districts have changed for the 2022 election. Either way, Part 2 of the election is the general election. In past elections 70% of Michigan districts were decided in the primary. With the re-districting, change may happen this election cycle. We cannot afford to be totally happy with a primary win. There are lot of issues that may draw more voters so Representative Walberg is on the top of the list. There will be others and now is the time to invite them to talk at a regional meeting or event. They are asking for voter input. Give it to them. The helmet debate is never over. The 10 year stats are important but it only takes one legislator to change our freedom in Michigan. On the federal level it's a duty to support the MRF. Motorcycle Riders Foundation has had our back for decades. AMA, American Motorcycle Association has been supportive to us. In the 80's-90's they were very involved with our legislation. We continue to have



Milford Police Department that the Michigan Helmet Law was repealed April 12, 2012 and signed into law. Needless to say I didn't get a ticket that day. 9 out of 10 years since the repeal more riders died wearing helmets. I hate to see any motorcyclists fatalities. If it was the other way around the opposition would be beating the drum for a mandatory helmet law. It doesn't matter. We need to stay active, involved, and present to be counted in Lansing.

This months news; California is starting

a program in six cities that will measure noise levels. You will get a ticket starting in 2023 if your bike is to loud. Some countries in Europe are offering cash incentives for older motorcycles if you turn in your older model bike or parts. The United States as you probably know is working on eliminating

internal combustible engines by 2035. Expect

for your internal combustible engine. There is no mention of motorcycles in the future when it comes to roads and infrastructure. There are so many issues affecting motorcycles on the state and federal level,

On a positive note, New Hampshire passed a Bill that prohibits motorcycle profiling.

If you bought anything from BikeBandit, you may have trouble getting your order. The website was is still up, but they declared bankruptcy in February. According to reports,

there is 646K dollars in customer orders that were never processed. Refund requests are never answered. There is no mention of bankruptcy on the website. At the time of bankruptcy, they claimed S705,000 in assets, 19




