The Motorcycle Safety Foundation's RiderCoach Prep class is an intensive training that takes experienced motorcyclists and turns them into MSF RiderCoaches. The class involves both classroom and hands-on (range) activities; there is a written pre-course assignment, a qualifying knowledge test, a written final exam, a riding-skills test, peer teaching, and student teaching.

We also require you to successfully complete, and shadow the instructors of, a Basic RiderCourse (BRC) – Web Enhanced before RiderCoach Prep in order to familiarize yourself with the curriculum you will ultimately instruct.
