The ARC is designed for experienced, endorsed motorcyclists to enhance their basic skills and help with personal risk assessment. Interactive classroom activities to improve perception and hazard awareness are combined with range exercises that enhance both basic skills and crash-avoidance skills. You will also learn how to improve braking and cornering finesse.

We are the only civilian training sponsor in the entire country to offer an oversized range (240x440) that is double the size of a standard range and specifically reserved for our Advanced RiderCourses. This range is located at our exclusive, seven-acre, obstruction-free training site, called the PSTC Driving Pad in Livonia. What does this mean for you as a student? You will obtain real-world speeds, hone your skills to an even greater extent, and take your riding to the next level!

This is the public version of the Military SportBike RiderCourse, but all motorcycle types are welcome! Students must provide their own motorcycle. Mopeds are **NOT** permitted. Three-wheeled motorcycles are **NOT** permitted. Sharing is **NOT** permitted. The motorcycle must be titled, registered, and insured; and it must display a valid license plate. Students must provide proof of insurance, and the motorcycle must pass a safety inspection.

Prerequisites:

- Motorcycle endorsement
- Ownership of a motorcycle that is titled, registered, and insured
- Considerable street-riding miles
- Valid email address on student profile (provide / update during registration)
