Very important to go on MRF website in order to answer Call to Action and see a synopsis of the bills.

Bill (RC) opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and then spoke about his efforts to gain members and to improve attendance at our meetings (see our appeal at the end of this report). Bill also reported the following...

- Special ABATE memberships now exist for young people under 18 years of age to help attract younger people to our organization.
