

Construction Notification

Liquid Road Seal Coat

In coordination with the City of Scottsdale, TALIS Construction will be applying a **Liquid Road Seal Coat** roadway application. Construction is scheduled weekdays 7 AM to 4 PM, **no parking will be allowed on either side of the street during work hours.** See Schedule Map on Reverse.

What Should I Expect?

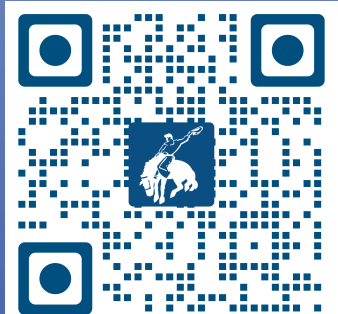
- ✚ **Do not drive on the street** until all barricades have been removed. Driving around barricades will damage the new surface. We are **not** responsible for vehicle/driveway clean-up if you drive through barricades.
- ✚ The Liquid Road Seal Coat will be applied per the Schedule Map on Reverse. Traffic will be redirected as needed.
- ✚ **All vehicles will need to be off both sides of the street by 6:30 am.** Any vehicle left on the street **WILL BE TOWED** at the owner's expense.
- ✚ The contractor will place no parking signs prior to the scheduled work. Please Park cars on the nearest street that is not scheduled to be sealed (refer to map). This includes moving cars from your garage and driveway.
- ✚ Access for businesses, neighborhoods, side streets, and driveways **will be limited** for the duration of the work, and delays may occur.

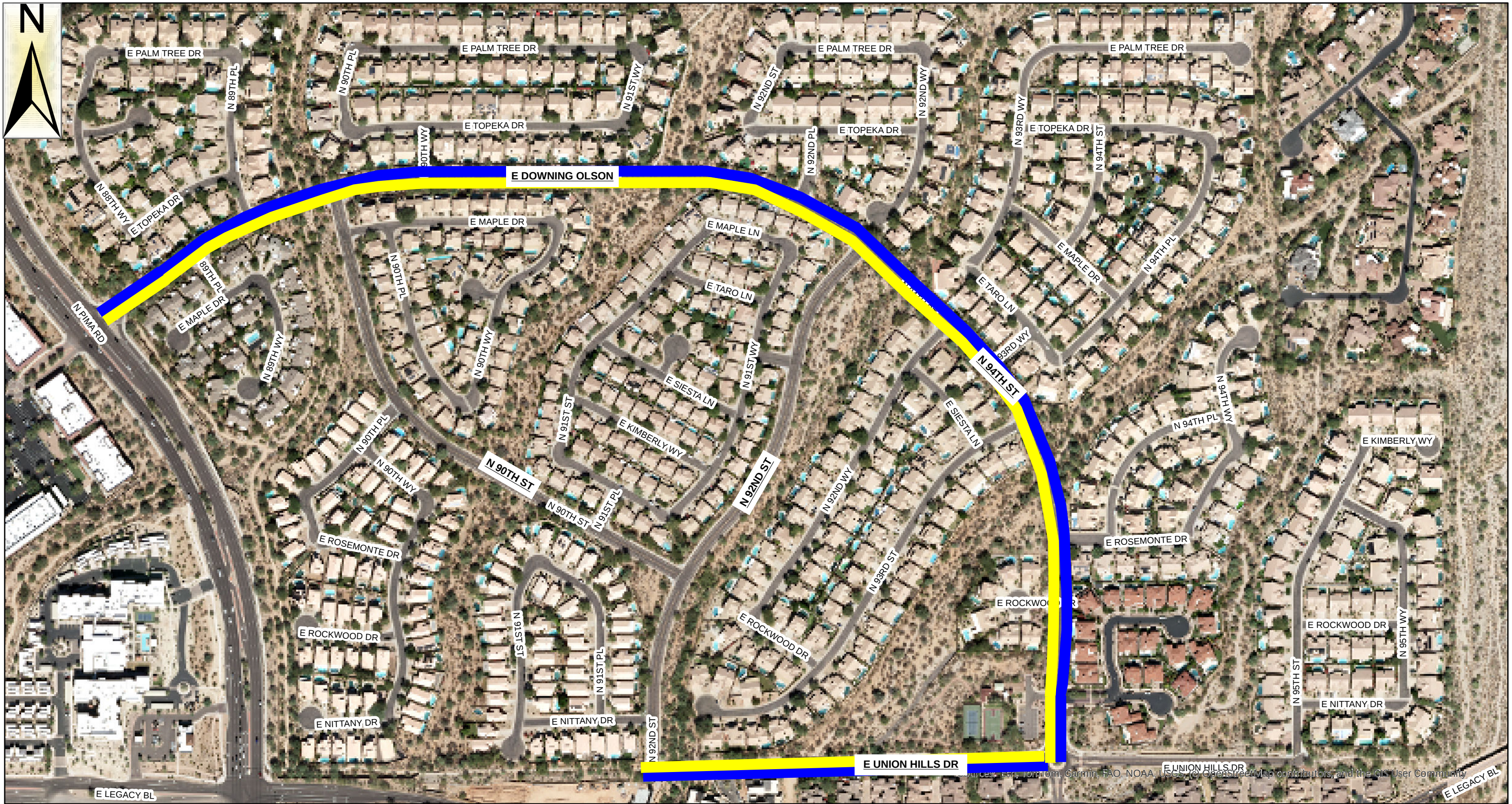
The schedule is subject to change due to weather or unforeseen circumstance. If it rains, you will be re-notified of the next scheduled date for restrictions.
