- The top of the mountain cannot be groomed, but it can be skied.
- Accident Investigation (AI) - Read Policy and Procedures pg 25--26
- AI - if it is a man-made object, it needs to have an AI
- List the types of Incident Accidents that require an AI
 - **Serious head injuries**
 - **Spinal injuries**
 - **Collisions of any kind**
 - **Lift-related incidents**
 - **Deaths**
 - **Incidents involving angry or critical guests.**
 - **Collision with a man-made object**
- Paid Patrol will be there to document the AI. The PIC is responsible for completing the Incident Report.
- If you see anyone making a jump, patrollers need to ask them to stop, remove it, or report it to management, and they will remove it.
- Can skiers do any aerials during jumps at KCSP? Patrollers said they have seen patrons doing flips and other stunts.

- Tower Pads
 - Two patrollers make the job easier,
 - Loosen straps,
 - Lift pad and shake to get snow off.
 - Kick snow underneath the pad; pad needs to be on top of the snow,
 - Tighten the straps from the bottom up to keep the pad in place
- Fencing responsibility - Mountain Team is in charge of fencing; however, we are a team. Help them out and do what you can.
