- O2 flow rate in trauma
  - Nasal 1-6
  - High flow 12-15
  - Little bottles are refilled after one use
  - Big bottles - Refilled at 500
- Ambulance calls are not the Hill Captain's decision, but the PIC's
  - Pic makes the determination if Ambulance is called
  - 911 - determines if ALS or BLS is needed.
- All radio communications and calls of assistance do not need to go through the Hill Captain
- PIC is PIC throughout the case or until they hand off to another patroller or to a higher level of care.
