Financial Update from Treasurer:

A quick update on the church finances going into the fall season. Even though our budget was trimmed for both donations and expenses due to covid, we are below our numbers to date. Our revenue is \$20,000 below what we were hoping for. The good news is our expenses are close to \$10,000 below projected as well. Our one major financial transaction we are required to pay before the end of the year is the federal CEBA loan of \$40,000 of which we can keep \$10,000 if we pay before the end of the year. September 2021 – Call for SK Synod Delegates for National Convention 2022

At the 2021 Synod Convention, the process was approved for nominating delegates to the ELCIC National Convention (2022 Assembly – Let There Be Greening) to be held in Calgary from July 12 – 15, 2022.

Saskatchewan Synod can send a total of 31 delegates: 12 rostered and 19 lay. Of that number, National Church requests that at least 1/5th or 6 delegates be between the ages of 16 – 30 as of the first day of convention.

If you are interested in attending as a Synod delegate, contact the office to get a form to be completed and returned by October 31, 2021. The information and form provided by the National Church is also available for review on the bulletin board. 😊
