

Role Description 10 - Cleaning Volunteers

Volunteering as a cleaner at Jubilee Hall is a practical and valuable way to help keep the hall welcoming, safe, and ready for everyone who uses it. Cleaning does not have to mean taking on a large amount of work. Volunteers can help with small, manageable tasks such as wiping tables, sweeping or mopping floors, emptying bins, checking toilets, tidying shared areas, or helping after an event.

This role is ideal for people who may only have a short amount of time to give but still want to make a real difference. Even helping with one job, one room, or one part of the hall can reduce the pressure on others and help keep Jubilee Hall clean and pleasant for visitors, volunteers, and the wider community.

Much of this work happens quietly in the background, but it has a big impact. A clean and cared-for hall helps people feel comfortable, shows pride in the building, and supports the smooth running of events and activities throughout the year.

1. Carry out small cleaning tasks
2. Wiping tables
3. Sweeping and hoovering floors
