- If the If the Quantity in Paragraph 2 above DOES NOT EXCEED the Exempt Quantity in Paragraph 3 above, then this load is an UN-REGULATED load of Normal Goods. The provisions of the Occupational Health and Safety Act concerning the safety of employees does still apply..

As can be seen from the above references, this load is Exempted Not Exempted from all requirements of the **National Road Traffic Act, 93 of 1996**, the **National Road Traffic Regulations, 1999** and **SANS 10231: 2014**.
