


WAS YOUR HOME DAMAGED IN A 2023/2024 FLOOD?

You may be eligible for a non-repayable grant!

SFRR Program provides federal grants to eligible homeowners whose primary residence was impacted by eligible 2023 and 2024 disasters.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

All Applicants:

- Must have sustained damages directly linked to one of the disasters
- Must have legally owned the home located in a Most Impacted and Distressed (MID) Area at the time of the disasters
- Must be a U.S. citizen or a qualified alien

Owner-Occupant Applicants:

- Must have occupied the home as their primary residence for 2 years at the time of the disaster
- May not own any additional properties
- Must be with household income less than 120 percent Area Median Income (AMI) Landlord Applicants:
- Must own the home and rent the property for 5 years to Low-to-Moderate Income (LMI) households
- May not apply for assistance for their owner-occupied home

TYPE OF ASSISTANCE

- Rehabilitation of primary residence or rental property
- Reconstruction of primary residence or rental property, including replacement of Manufactured Housing Units (MHUs)
- Reimbursement of Program-approved eligible rehab./reconstruction expenses
- Elevation of properties eligible for reconstruction located in a FEMA Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA)
- Flood insurance payments for up to 2 years

- Proof of U.S. Citizenship or Lawful Permanent Residency
- Proof of Occupancy
- Proof of Income
- 2023/24 Disaster Assistance Received
- Properties Owned by Trust
- Properties with a Mortgage
- Proof of Ownership
- Proof of Damage from the Disaster
- Proof of Current Property Taxes
