Today, your child learned about a man named Daniel. Daniel loved God and talked to him, even though there was a law against it. When the king found out that Daniel was praying to God, he threw Daniel into a den full of lions! That would be so scary! But Daniel did the right thing and trusted God to keep him safe. Help your child make their own lions' den to help them remember that they can trust God just like Daniel.



Here's what to do:



Build a fort using blankets or a cardboard box and have your child gather their favorite stuffed animals.



Encourage them to pretend to be lions (along with their animal friends) like those in the den with Daniel. See who can roar the loudest!



After the roaring, have them yell, "I can trust God!" Remind them that Daniel trusted God, and they can trust God too.
