- Help them draw all of the members of a royal family who live in a castle (king, queen, prince, princess, etc.). Talk about each person as you draw them.
- When you mention the Queen, talk to your child about how brave Queen Esther was and how she trusted God to do the right thing.
- Talk about all of the different ways you can trust God to do the right thing too!
