

Call for Papers "Política, Revista de Ciencia Política"

(No. 2, December 2023)

<u>Política, Revista de Ciencia Política</u> is a biannual publication from the School of Government at the Universidad de Chile since 1982. Its objective is to disseminate research generated in the main currents of political science, aiming toward the consolidation of this discipline in Chile and Latin America. This is a peer-reviewed open-access journal with no article publication fees.

The journal's 2023 Number 2 will be published in December 2023. It will address issues related to **Migration and Politics**. We will co-edit this number with Dr. Ernesto Castañeda, Director of the Center for Latin American and Latino Studies and founding Director of The Immigration Lab at **American University**.

Articles and other relevant themes are also welcome for the journal's permanent call for papers, which will also be considered for this issue. Political science, public policy, and social science papers dealing with migration and politics widely understood are welcome.

Articles must be submitted through the platform on the journal's website: <u>https://revistapolitica.uchile.cl/</u> following its editorial guidelines, with a maximum length of 8,000 words. All papers will undergo a double-blind review process. Original articles are welcome in Spanish, English, and Portuguese. Accepted articles will be published in the second issue of December 2023. Article submissions for this issue will be received until September 25, 2023.
