- 1. Run at speed to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback no hesitation.
- 2. Run to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback no hesitation.
- 3. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena at least ten feet (3m). Hesitate.
- 4. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
- 5. Complete four and one-quarter spins to the left so that horse is facing left wall or fence. Hesitate.
- 6. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- 7. Complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- 8. Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run straight down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (6.09m) from the wall or fence. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.



Working Cow Horse Pattern #9

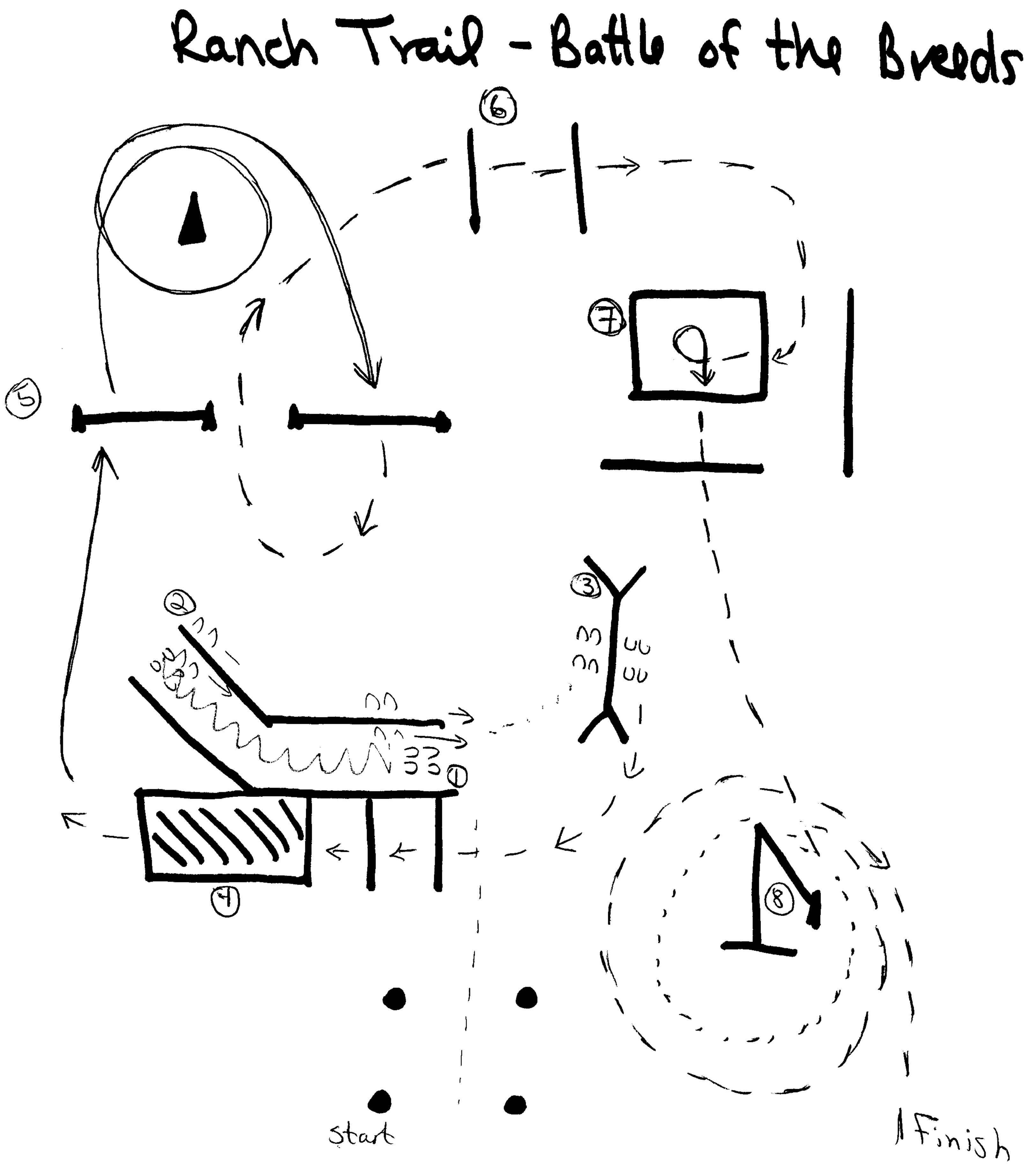


Trot to center of arena, stop. Start pattern facing towards judge.
1. Beginning on the right lead, complete 3 circles to the right; the first circle small and slow followed by 2 large fast circles. Change leads at the center of the arena.

- 2. Complete 3 circles to the left, the first circle small and slow followed by 2 large fast circles. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- 3. Continue around end of arena without breaking gait or changing leads, run down center of arena past end marker, and execute a square
 - sliding stop.
- 4. Complete 3¹/₂ spins to the left.
- 5. Run down center of arena past end marker, and execute a square sliding stop.
- 6. Complete $3\frac{1}{2}$ spins to the right.
- 7. Run down center of arena past center marker, and execute a square sliding stop.
- 8. Back up at least 10 feet.

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9. Hesitate to complete pattern.



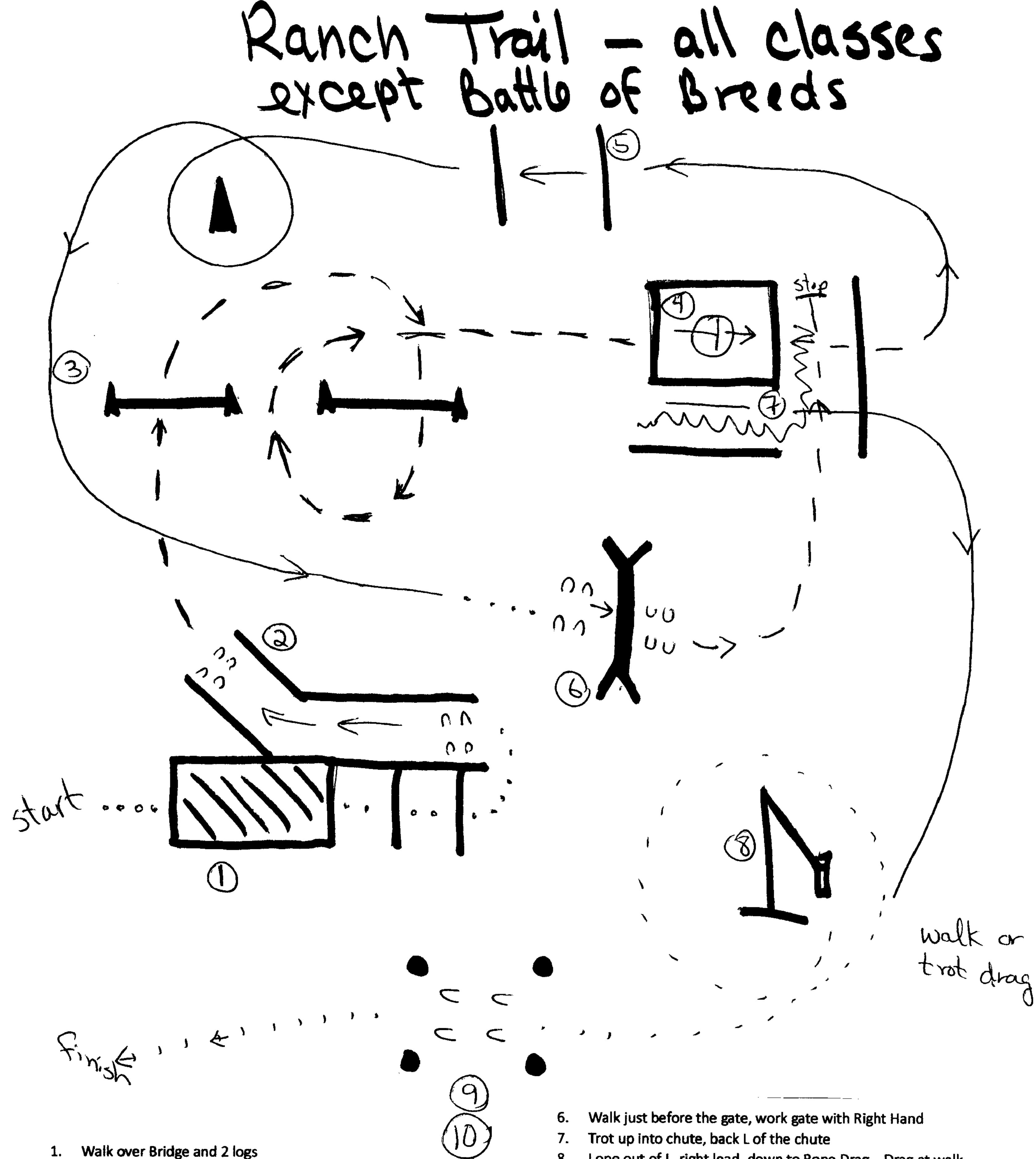
- Walk between cones, then back L 1.
- Side pass right over log 2.

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- Walk to Gate, Right hand push 3.
- Trot to and over logs and bridge 4.
- Lope right lead over pole and around marker 5. As shown – Trot before second pole

- 6. Trot over 2 logs and into box as shown
- Turn 270 to right and trot out of box and over pole 7.
- Trot to Rope Drag Drag at walk in a circle to the right, 8. Then drag at trot a circle to the right, Replace rope and drag where you found it, trot out



- Side pass Left between logs 2.

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- Extended Trot over and around logs as shown 3.
- Trot into the box, 360 degree turn either direction 4.
- Trot out of box, then lope left lead over logs and around 5. marker as shown

- Lope out of L, right lead, down to Rope Drag Drag at walk 8. or trot in a circle to the right, then replace rope and drag (Youth do not drag, just trot around the rope drag marker)
- Walk Horse into the square Dismount and Ground tie. 9. Walk AROUND the horse either direction OUTSIDE the markers
- Lead horse out of arena at a trot 10.

Walk Trot classes will not lope. Trot where the lope sections are.

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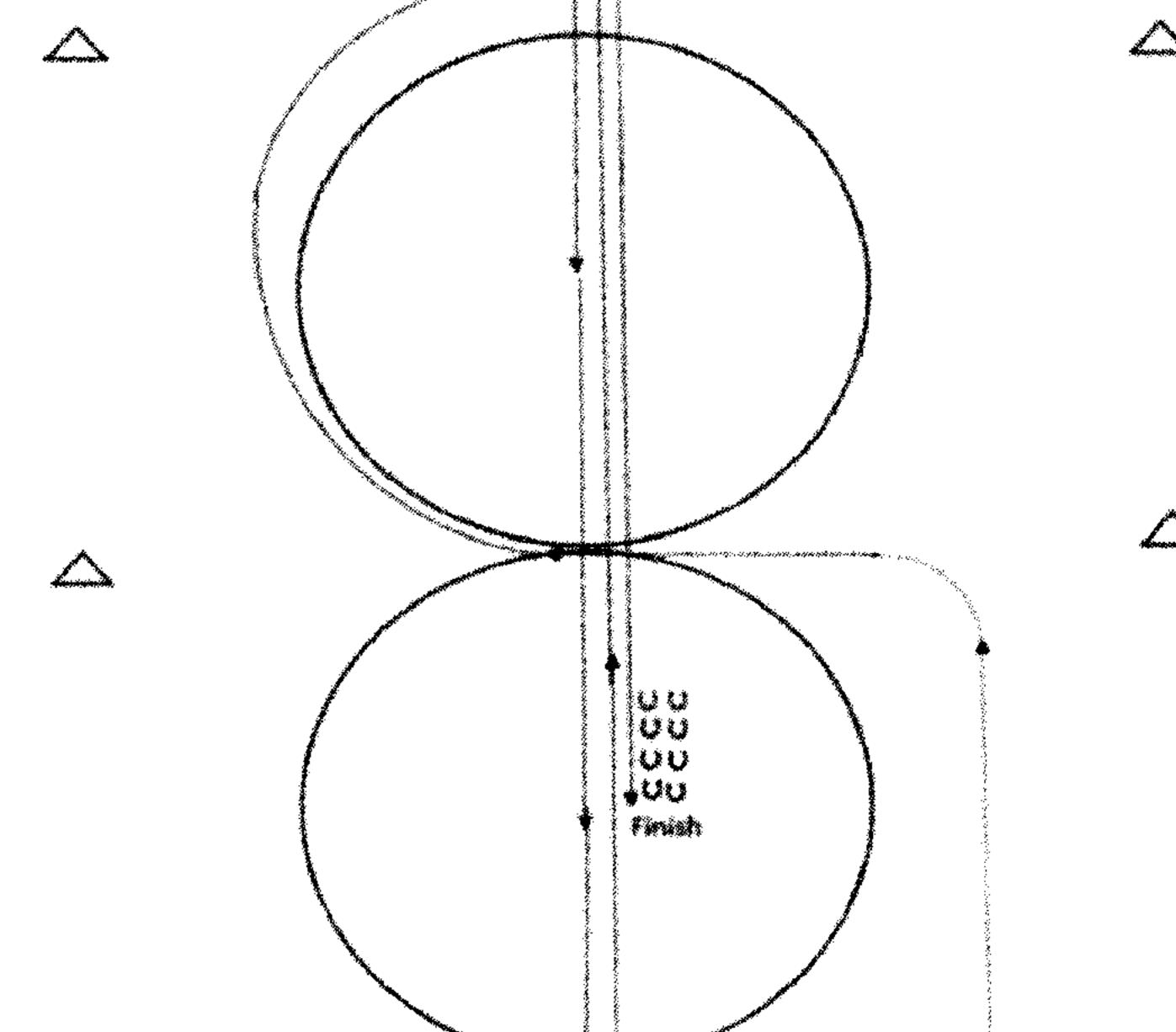

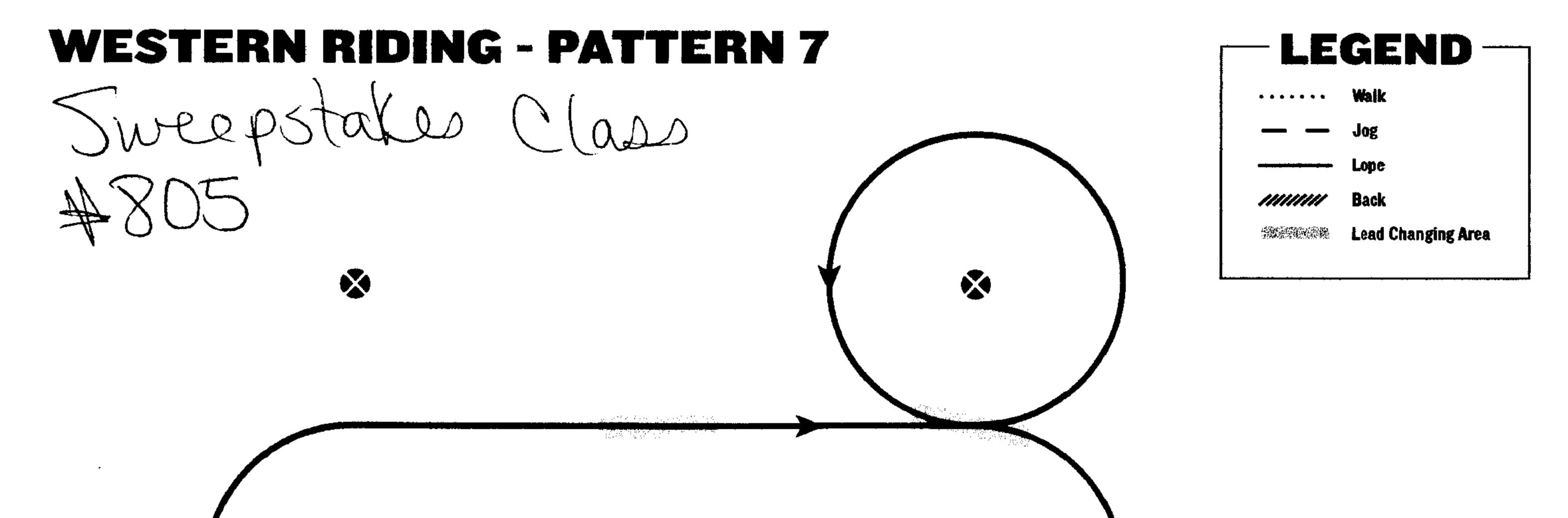
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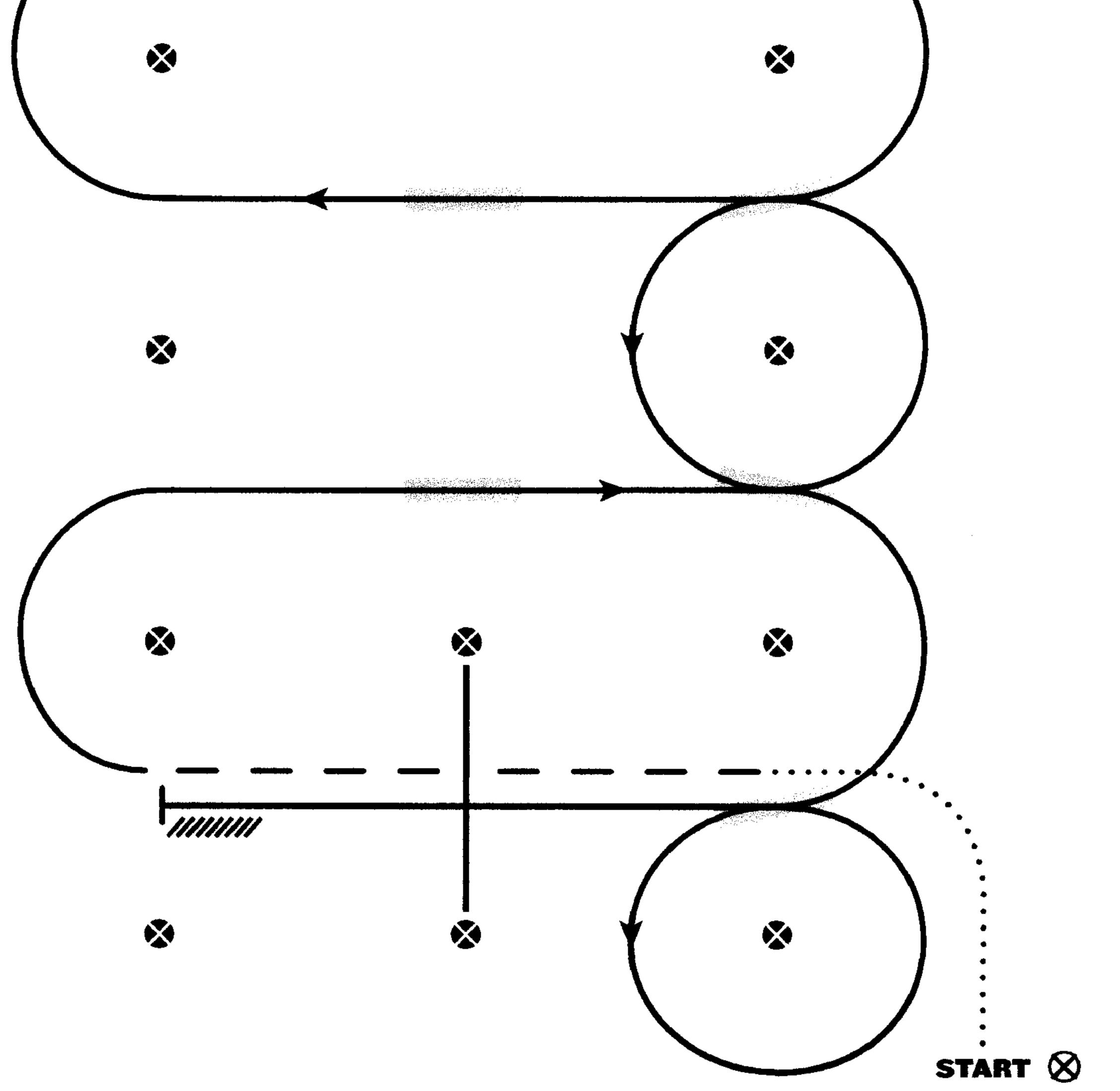




Trot to center of Arena, Stop. Start pattern facing towards Judge.

- 1. Beginning on the right lead Lope one circle to the right, Change Leads to the left.
- 2. Complete one circle to the left, Change leads to the right and go to the top of arena.
- 3. Run down center of arena past the end marker and come to stop.
- 4. Complete 1 1/2 spins to right
- 5. Run to the other end of the arena, past the end marker and come to a stop.
- 6. Complete 1 1/2 spins to the left.
- 7. Run past the center marker, stop, back 10 feet.
- 8. Hesitate to complete pattern.





- I. Walk at least 15 feet from start cone to the first marker, as drawn, transition to jog, jog over log.
- 2. Transition to the lope right lead
- 3. First crossing change
- 4. Second crossing change
- 5. Third crossing change
- 6. Circle & first line change

- 8. Stop at C; perform a 90 degree turn to the left on the forehand.

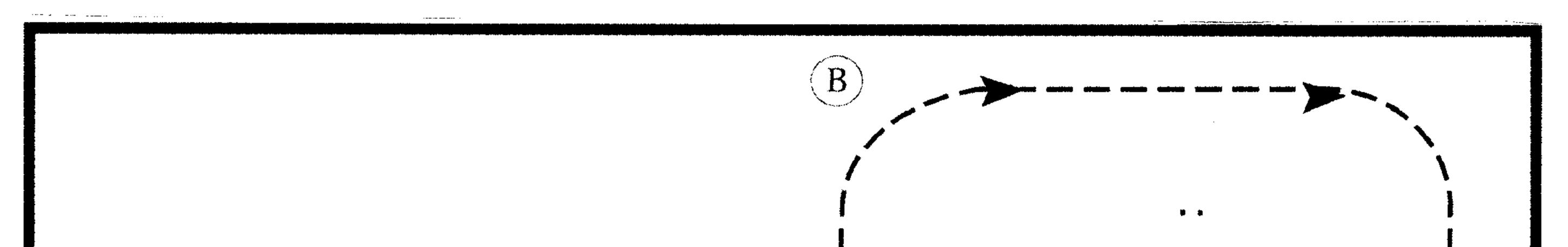

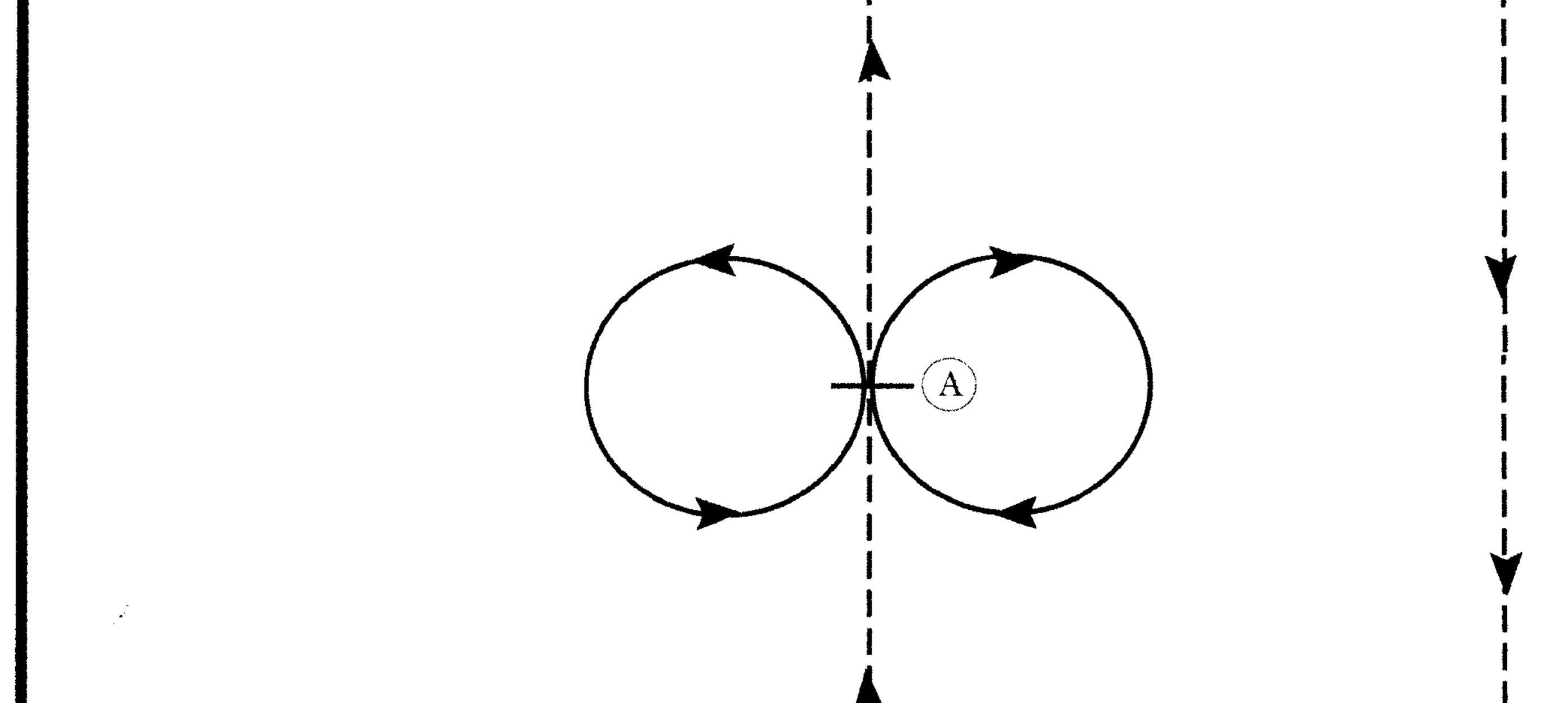
