Joseph Frank gave a presentation on unified, uniform CPR training throughout the county. Resuscitation academy has been training instructors and they are working on the curriculum that will be distributed to all agencies.

Theoretical timeline:

May- finish up on how to apply a LUCAS device.

June-ALS/BLS transition work done and given to WCEMS for approval.

Need core group of ALS instructors to train. Funding will be needed.

North Region:

Reported our KPI on calls as related to transfers to the trauma center.

Gave trauma review.

New people were voted into leadership at the executive meeting.

May 6th- 4-hour online training offered. The training includes falls and falls prevention, suicide and PTSD for first responders.

Training Officers:

Training Survey: training officers were interested in seeing breakdown. Looking at Academy coinciding with EMT Schedule

K. Jorgensen brought forward data on nitrous, BLS code red calls, CPR and equipment failures.

Epcr committee was formed through the operations committee and is now named Operations Data Completeness group.
