REPORTS:

North Region: next meeting is on January 28th

Funding:

There have been cuts at state that could affect prehospital participation grant.

Received a grant for a Resuscitation academy. S. Cohen is working on putting the program together.

SALT Kits- Motion was made (D. McLane) and approved to ask council for \$1500 to purchase carabiner with strap and tape for 64 kits.

Training Officers Report:

Did not have a meeting in November. First quarter will have a lot of training.

CQI:

Still working on case review.

Need to work on getting recordings from dispatch and data off Lifepak in timely manner. Discussed moving EMS Coordinator into co-chair position.

Providers are not getting feedback on COVID-19 flagged patients. Some smaller districts don't have epic access. Hilley working on bidirectional feed on Epic. ImageTrend email could be used but it's a manual push.

Tiffany Hansen is providing feedback to districts she is servicing twice a week.

Use of PPE is the best way to protect yourself.

There has been no feedback from funeral homes. M. Hilley will call Health Dept and check in about funeral home feedback.

Hospital won't invest in hospital information exchange. Health Dept is not letting agencies know about Covid-19 positive patients.

Bellingham was asked to print out patient cares records and take to ED because hospital didn't know how to access them.

Ecpr records are on hospital hub that no one is accessing.

Hospital seems to be unaware they can access the information. Hospital needs to manage the access and they are not doing it.

Bi-directional communication is needed.

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Unfinished Business:

CPR manikins are ready to be checked out and will be stored in the council office. Steve and Andrea will create an online reservation form and manage the reservation/check out/check in process.

Nebs: Video is ready to go out.
