Dr. Junck suggested creating a video that could be played at each course.

Projector:

The council would like a projector it could use and loan out for ASHI Training, meetings, etc.

M Hilley moved and S. Ryckman seconded the recommendation to ask the general council of a \$500 budget for the purchase of a projector. Motion approved by all.

The BLS protocols concerning Nitrous were not correct. M. Hilley will put a notice in Image Trend.

Dr. Wayne gave the green light for ALS & BLS protocols to be combined. Dr. Junck is working on it and will continue working on it.

The Hospital is still having ongoing issues with unclean equipment in the shed.

M. Hilley met with Susie Johnson this morning. There was talk about installing a camera to find out who is putting dirty equipment in the shed.

M. Hilley will invite S. Johnson to the next chiefs meeting.

EMS trauma steering committee-
