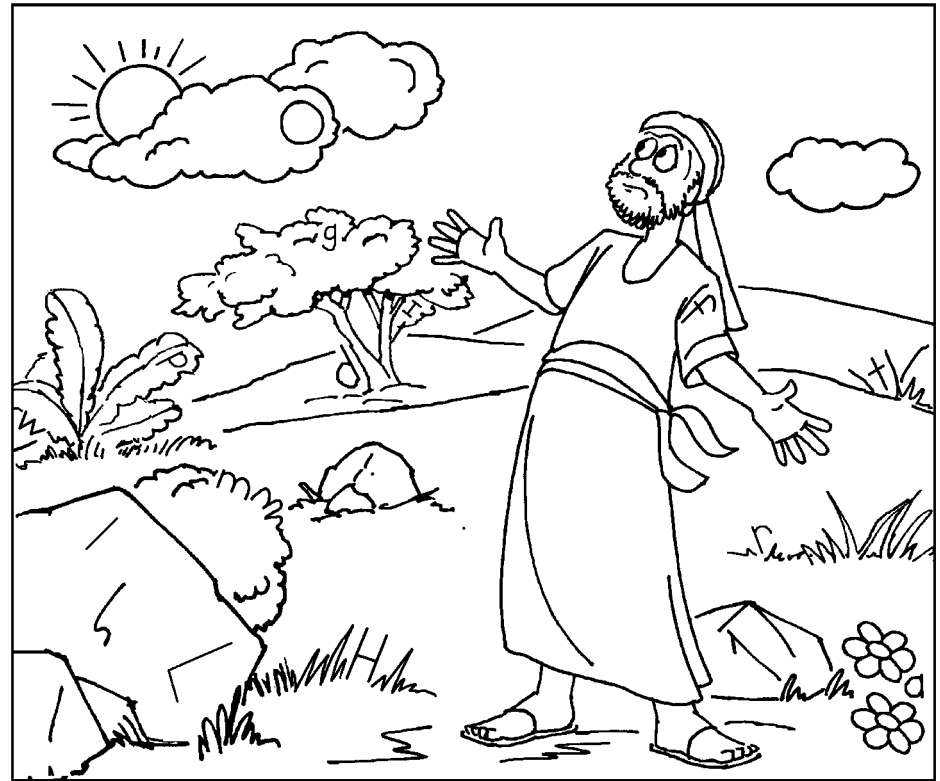

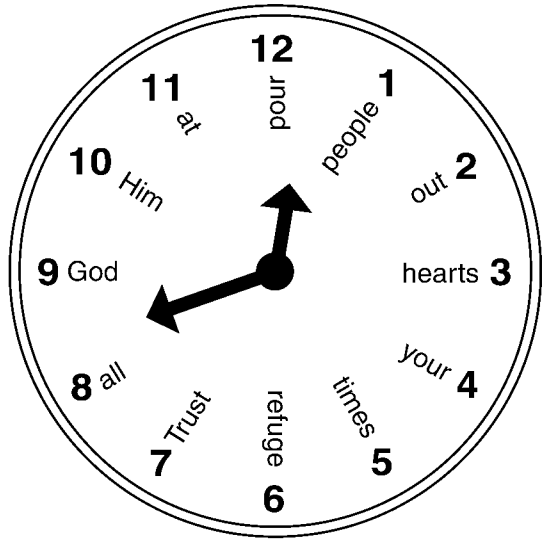

This psalm praises God saying, "He alone is my rock and my salvation; He is my fortress, I will never be shaken."

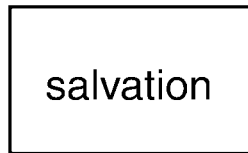
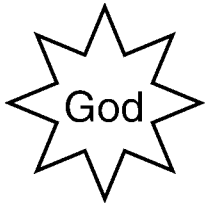
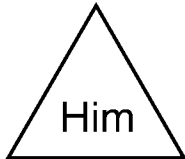
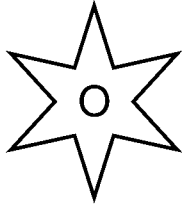
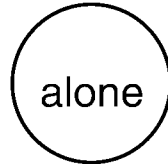
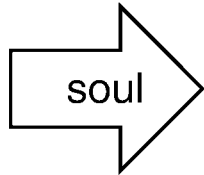
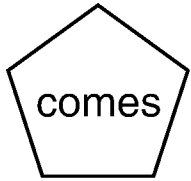
