

Solve the puzzle using the clock face and the times shown.



This psalm praises God saying, "He alone is my rock and my salvation; He is my fortress, I will never be shaken."


Draw lines from the rock to the pictures showing instances of God's protection over those who trust in Him.
















What does this psalm say about feeling confident in God's protection?

We can truly feel strong if we depend on God's strength.






