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2020 ENROLMENTS AND END OF YEAR ACCOUNTS

We have all enrolments finalised for new families beginning in 2020.

If families would like to change their attendance this can be organised by letting us know any other days you would prefer so that we can make a note on our internal waiting list. To reduce days we require 2 weeks' notice from 7 Jan 2020. Most of our families who have children leaving the centre have had their bonds allocated to final fee balances. Anyone who indicated they would prefer their bond refunded needs to ensure that they have a nil balance on their account by Wednes

Day 18 December and then we will refund bond monies into directed accounts.

END OF YEAR ACCOUNTS

All families have been emailed an Invoice showing fee weeks from the end of November 2019 to the end of our first week of operation in January 2020.

Balances owing for 2019 are due by WEDNESDAY 18th DECEMBER, 2019.

If you are still unsure of your balance due by the end of this year, please contact office staff for clarification.

From the week starting 13/1/20 we will advise families of their new 2020 weekly fees via email.

We recommend that families then adjust their direct deposit payments to reflect their new fee amounts as per that invoice.

Families with siblings starting in 2020 will be advised of their new fees for that child in the new year.

Please feel free to contact Mel or Kim to discuss plans to finalise your account if you are predicting that you may need more time to finalise.

We are happy to work with families experiencing difficulties especially at this time of year as long as we have open communication and a plan of action in place.

The program will involve sessions of recognising strengths in ourselves and others, immersing ourselves in courageous conversations around professional identity through the medium of clay and expressive arts, exploring multiple ways of seeing and working together and small group discussions with room teams that focus on critical pausing and moving into a new year with new and old team members. We share a special lunch together and organise the play rooms ready for children and families the next day.

Wednesday 11 December nine of our 2-3 year Joeys went on an excursion to Cardiff Heights to visit an urban farm. They have been learning a lot about growing food, composting and worm farms so to build on this learning we decided to visit David and Matthew from Feedback Organic at their won-

derful farm in Cardiff Heights. We were able to see lots of crops growing, we tasted edible flowers, herbs and lots of greens. We learnt all about their huge big stinky compost and how all the scraps from Cafes and restaurants all around Newcastle are collected by David and brought back to the farm to help enrich the soil to grow more food. The children were then able to do some planting in a newspaper cylinder and bring back to the centre some planted bean seeds and a silverbeet seed-

ling. This was so very exciting and lots of fun! We had a wonderful morning



at the farm and we were so proud of the children. They were so engaged, focused and eager to learn and participate. We hope they remember it forever:)
