

Code of Conduct

As a club, Spey Runners members come together to participate and enjoy a common interest in running. The Code of Conduct acts as a reminder of the standards of behaviour which we can all share. Members are expected to recognise that the organised activities of the club depend on the time and efforts of volunteers who give a significant amount of their time for the benefit of the club.

Members or a person acting on behalf of the club are expected to:

- Behave with respect to other members of the club, other runners and members of the public.
- Take responsibility for their own safety and not compromise the safety of others.
- Behave in accordance with all policies of the club.
- Respect and comply with the rules and regulations of competitions that they may participate in or assist with as an official.
- Not publish defamatory material or behave in a manner that may bring the club into disrepute.
- Follow the Complaints Procedure if at any time they have cause for concern for the welfare, safety or behaviour of others.
