

Thanks for coming! Please clean up your campsite of any trash and return unused firewood to shelters, take care of your fire pits.

Junior shooters: are ages 12-15. At 16, you must shoot with adults. Juniors may shoot in the adult shoots, but no cross sticks/rests are allowed and will be scored as an adult!

Cook-Off Details:

Judges will be visiting each camp. Once registration closes Saturday evening, Marva will get with all that entered and let them know what time the judges will be at their camp on Sunday Morning. While at the camp, the participant(s) will be able to wine and dine the three judges any way they want. Time spent at each camp will depend on how many entries but approximately 15 minutes. Judging will be done in 4 categories totaling 100 points overall. Categories are not all based on 25 points. Some categories will have a higher point limit. Highest point total will win. Ties will be broken by the judges as Marva will have them discuss those meals that are tied. All meals must be cooked on-site over an open fire-either coal or wood.

Judging Categories include:

1. - Authenticity of the food itself (how period correct the food is to the mountain man 1810-1880)
2. - Taste and appearance of food (Flavor, texture, aroma)
3. - Authenticity of service (is the food served like it would be to a mountain man 1810-1880)
4. - Delivery of food
