Download to phone/tablet or print out directions to take along with you

Cell phone reception spotty in area, best on AT&T & Verizon

Two places map programs may get it wrong for our location

1. Hit "DETOUR BY ROAD" if available in any program that tries to send you down BOY SCOUT CAMP ROAD (You'll see an open fence entrance & mailboxes at Saddle Creek Rd. within 25 feet of a yellow NO OUTLET sign.

2. About a block after entering Saddle Creek dirt-road, turn left at V/curve to stay on Saddle Creek Farms Road.

Most programs have correct map picture but some say to turn wrong way

FROM I-4 in Sanford

- Exit 108, DeBary/Deltona city limit sign/Enterprise exit
- East/left 8 miles on CR4162 Dirksen/Deltona/Doyle roads as you drive toward Osteen
- Right/south at SR415 traffic light

- Continue south through Doyle/CR4162 traffic light

Heading south on SR415 in Osteen:

- Pass Skip's Boots, Fox Head bar/lounge on right
- **Third left onto New Smyrna Road** immediately after leaving Doyle Road/CR4162 (just before Volusia County biking/hiking overpass & fire station)

FROM State Road 46 in Sanford

East to Lake Mary Blvd./State Road 415

Left/north on SR415, over bridge

First right turn onto New Smyrna Blvd. (just before the first traffic light after leaving SR46, immediately after crossing Volusia County biking/hiking overpass & fire station)

Routes match from here:

- **Immediate left on Florida Ave.**, quickly becomes Osteen-Maytown Road
- **5.6 miles east on Osteen-Maytown Road** before you turn again
- Speed trap – 30 mph speed limit traveling eastward until you pass the golf course
- Signs posted, paw prints painted on power poles starting on Osteen-Maytown Road, to reassure that you are headed correct way

To Pell Road (5.6 miles to get there):

- After two small bridges

- Pass Vat & Elizabeth roads on right, pass Rebel Run on left, shortly before you reach Pell
- Yellow traffic sign says Pell as you approach - comes up fast
- Small yellow Lucas Palms sign just before turning north on Pell
- Towards Wiregrass Prairie Reserve

Left/north on Pell Road for exactly 4 miles

- Next turn is **Saddle Creek Farms Road** (PASS Prideaux & PASS Oakridge Farms roads on right BEFORE that)
- Paw prints painted on occasional power poles
- Cell phone reception tends to go out briefly before & after this intersection

Right/east on Saddle Creek Farms Road (dirt road)

IF PAVEMENT ON PELL ROAD RUNS OUT BEFORE YOU TURN ON SADDLE CREEK YOU HAVE GONE TOO FAR – TURN AROUND NOW! SUGAR SAND AHEAD AFTER PELL BECOMES A DIRT ROAD.

Paw print pointing right on last power pole on right - look for Saddle Creek on your right.

Short block to next turn: Left at that intersection to remain on Saddle Creek Farms Road. Some GPS programs make it sound like you should turn the wrong way at this intersection

No Outlet sign just before turn onto **Saddle Creek Farms Road**

- Last side street on right before Pavement Ends warning sign

- Saddle Creek Farms sign on fencing & street sign
- Double bank of mailboxes on right – turn in between gates
- You are invited guests - ignore No Trespassing sign at Saddle Creek entrance
- Watch out for similar names along Pell & in Saddle Creek.

10 MILES PER HOUR on 1 mile of safe-when-slow dirt roads to our property

Speeding can get you expelled from class with no refund because it messes up cars & roads

Landmarks help in Saddle Creek -- few street signs

Avoid drainage ditches - don't drive over any drainage pipe areas.

Drive slowly, no more than 10 miles per hour, once you get to our dirt road to protect children & avoid frightening horses & other livestock, as well as local wildlife. We regularly see deer, wild turkeys, hawks, bald eagles & more so take a deep breath -- did you know how close the countryside can be found out here?

Lower speeds also help preserve the road work done so far. In most sections, if there are any low spots, get up on the grass there and go very slowly as you watch for any new washouts.

Very few street signs after you leave Pell

- **Right at Oak View Plantation Road.** Only way to go on road here as you pass 2-story house on your right (road runs between horse & cattle pastures
- **Immediate next (first) left at Oak Haven Plantation Road**
- **Second home on right**

- Lots of dog signs on fence
- Green-roofed storage building in back with large red paw prints
- Driveway near center of front fence
- Agility & obedience rings with jumps & other equipment in front fields on either side of driveway
- Dog signs on fence

Please park behind the house in sunny weather – accessible parking in front of house

- Covered training pavilion & white training building next to driveway

You must get to Pell by coming up Osteen-Maytown Road which is easy from Sanford. (Avoid any directions that try to send you to us via Boy Scout Camp Road).

DRIVING DIRECTIONS FROM NORTH & WEST

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Two places map programs may get it wrong for our location

1. Hit **"DETOUR BY ROAD"** if available in any program that tries to send you down **BOY SCOUT CAMP ROAD** (impassable sugar sand, usually only for 4-wheel drive & off-road vehicles only. (You'll can see an open fence entrance & mailboxes at Saddle Creek Rd. within 25 feet of a yellow NO OUTLET sign. Turn around and go south on State Road 415 if you still

see Boy Scout Camp Road on your map. Enter our part of Osteen further south, near Volusia County biking/hiking overpass on SR415)

2. About a block after entering Saddle Creek dirt-road, turn left at V/curve to stay on Saddle Creek Farms Road.

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FROM I-4, south Deltona, DeBary, Orange City, South DeLand, West Seminole County (Heathrow, Sanford)

- Exit 108, DeBary/Deltona city limit sign/Enterprise exit
- East/left 8 miles on CR4162 Dirksen/Deltona/Doyle roads as you drive toward Osteen
- Right/south at SR415 traffic light

FROM Daytona/New Smyrna, Deltona, SR44, Howland Blvd via SR415.:

- South on SR415 (TELL GPS TO DETOUR AROUND BOY SCOUT CAMP RD)
- A little more than 1 mile south past WalMart at Howland Blvd. & SR415
- Continue south through Doyle/CR4162 traffic light

Heading south on SR415 in Osteen:

- Pass Skip's Boots, Fox Head bar/lounge on right
- Third left onto New Smyrna Road immediately after leaving Doyle Road/CR4162 (just before Volusia County biking/hiking overpass & fire station)
- Immediate left on Florida Ave., quickly becomes Osteen-Maytown Road
- 5.6 miles east on Osteen-Maytown Road before you turn again
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- Double bank of mailboxes on right – turn in between gates
- You are invited guests - ignore No Trespassing sign at Saddle Creek entrance
- Turn right before passing sign that says Pavement Ends
- Watch out for similar names along Pell & in Saddle Creek.

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
