There are seven states in which all businesses need to obtain state business licenses, in addition to any required local licenses. Each Virginia city and county establishes its own licensing requirements and procedures. But most counties and cities require the appropriate Virginia business licenses or permits for all businesses, including one-person, home-based operations.
