Listed Below is pricing to repair an existing jetty for the Chapman Beach Assoc.

- 1. Mobilize all tools and equipment to the site.
- 2. Deconstruct existing Jetty set rock aside for reuse.
- 3. Excavate down roughly 2' along the outer side of the jetty.
- 4. Place filter fabric along the new trench.
- 5. Place new 5-7 ton toe stone along the trench.
- 6. Reuse large stone to build up either side of the jetty with a 1' to 1' slope.
- 7. Incorporate existing stone inside of the new jetty.
- 8. Wrap with the filter fabric.
- 9. Incorporate 6-8" rip rap for interlocking the jetty stone.
- 10. Place the flattest rocks along the top of the new jetty.
- 11. Do a final clean up and remove all tools and equipment.

Total for work listed above = \$96,450
