USER INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL INFORMATION

In order to provide you with suitable wastewater disposal, your home is serviced by a low pressure sewer system. The key element in this system is the Myers grinder pump. The tank collects all raw sewage from the house. The solid materials are then ground into a fine slurry to be pumped to the wastewater treatment line and then to the treatment facility. This pump will provide years of service through routine preventative maintenance (provided yearly by us) and by each user carefully following just a few simple guidelines and communicating flushing restrictions to all family members and visitors.

PUMP FAILURE ALARM

Your grinder system is provided with an **alarm** that will signal in the event of a high water level in the pit. **This consists of a flashing red light and an audio alarm**. These alarms provide adequate warning to the user that service is <u>required</u>. **Please contact us for service** <u>immediately</u> **if you notice that the alarm is activated and** <u>discontinue all flushing/draining</u> in your home until our maintenance technician gets there to troubleshoot and fix the problem causing the alarm!

FOR SERVICE 24/7, CALL IMMEDIATELY – (260) 609-9680 PLEASE DON'T WAIT AS WAITING ONLY INCREASES THE REPAIR TIME!

CAUTION: DO NOT DISCONNECT POWER TO THE UNIT!

Your grinder pump cannot dispose of wastewater without electrical power. If electric service is interrupted to your grinder **or** inside your home, keep water usage to a bare minimum until restored.

CARE AND USE FOR THE MYERS GRINDER PUMP

The Myers grinder pump is capable of accepting and pumping a wide range of materials found in domestic sewage. Regulatory agencies advise that the **following items should** <u>never be introduced</u> into any sewer either directly, through a kitchen waste disposal unit, or by flushing down a toilet.

GLASS, METAL, PLASTIC (TOYS, UTENSILS, ETC.), SANITARY NAPKINS OR TAMPONS, SEAFOOD SHELLS, WIPES (BABY, PERSONAL FACE OR CLEANING), DIAPERS, RAGS, CLOTHING, ETC.

In addition, you must <u>not use</u> products advertised as "safe for septic systems" and <u>NEVER</u> introduce into any sewer any of the following:

EXPLOSIVES, FLAMMABLE MATERIAL, OIL, GREASE, STRONG CHEMICALS, GASOLINE

PERIODS OF DISUSE

You should have no problems at all with your grinder pump if you leave your home unoccupied for an extended period of time.
