

# **AGED CARE REFORMS**

On 1st November 25 the Australian Government implemented the biggest Aged Care reforms in a generation, with the Aged Care Act 2024 and the new Support at Home program. These once in a generation changes enshrine the rights of older Australians in law and create a system to deliver safe, dignified and high-quality care for our ageing population.

The reforms respond to 58 recommendations of the Royal Commission into Aged Care Quality & Safety. At the heart of the new Act is a commitment to empower older Australians with choice and control over their lives and the care they receive, while setting the system up to handle the challenges Australia will face as our population ages and the community's expectations of aged care evolve.

With the support of our volunteers, businesses, schools and other community organisations, Meals on Wheels are doing our part to ensure we deliver a high-quality service to our clients which assists them to remain living independently at home and keeps them connected to the people and the places they love.

#### STAYING ON THE NDIS AFTER 65 YEARS

The NDIS is available to people who apply before their 65<sup>th</sup> Birthday. Aside from age, people must meet the eligibility criteria to receive an NDIS plan. Among these is that they have a disability caused by permanent impairment. Someone may lose NDIS eligibility if their impairment improves, even if their disability remains.

NDIS plans are reviewed regularly to see if they still meet someone's needs, as well as their eligibility.

### **MEALS ON WHEELS FOOD SAFETY**

For the health & safety of our clients we remind all volunteers **not to leave meals if a client is not at home.** 

Vulnerable persons are more susceptible to food poisoning. Food stored between 5°C and 60°C for 2 – 4 hours needs to be consumed immediately. If not eaten, then refrigerated

If the client is not at home to receive their meal, please phone the clients contact on the Runcard to enquire of their whereabouts and then inform the service. Return the meal to the **ADINA CARE** kitchen so it can be refrigerated immediately.
