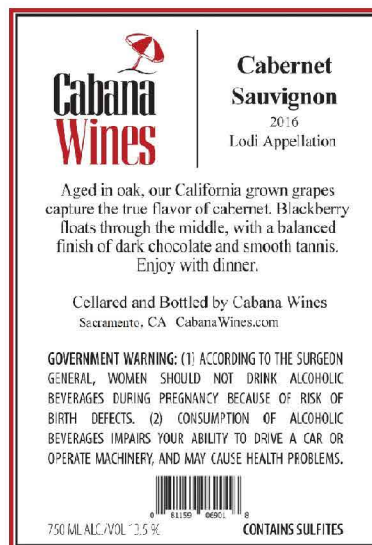
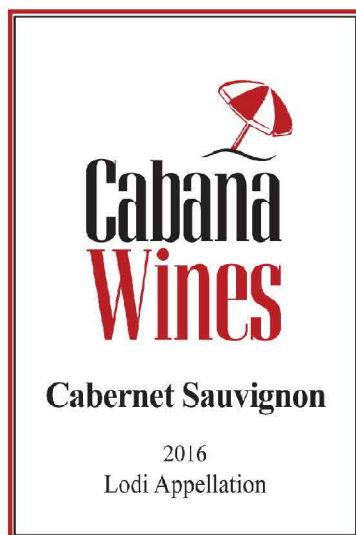
Cabernet Sauvignon 97% Petit Sirah 2% Tennant 1%

A beautiful dark ruby color and a wonderful spicy aromas fill the senses. A lovely mid pallet of lush blackberry with hints of oak and tannin. A well balanced wine with a smooth as silk finish with hints mocha. A nice sipping wine that will only improve with age.

Pairs well with Filet Mignon,, portabella mushrooms, dark chocolate and cheddar or Huntsman cheeses.

The 2014 harvest was small, but excellent fruit. Lodi was blessed with warm days and cool nights, allowing the Cabernet grapes to mature. The wine has excellent tannin structure and its is well balanced. Aged in Oak this is a wine that is very drinkable young. It will improve in time if you care to wait. This is a great sipping Cabernet.
