A big bold wine, ripe in flavors of blackberries, coffee and toasted oak. A full bodied wine, with nice acid and good tannins make this a "plush" feel on your palate. The dark berry flavor and hints of oak linger on the smooth finish.

Pairs well with BBQ, Mexican food, grilled meats and spicy bold cooking.

The 2016 vintage was succulent, and well balanced. Normally we make Petite Sirah as a blending wine for our Cabernet, but you will agree with me this new vineyard produces a lush full flavored wine that is ready to drink from the bottle
